Father Jerome's Message ... Fiery Peace (Luke 12:49-53)

How can the "Prince of Peace" say that he has come to bring not peace, but division? Perhaps we must look for the key to his words in his parting words at the Last Supper: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives" (Jn 14:27). So, the peace that Jesus offers is qualitatively different from the kind of peace the world understands. It is not a peace that is all about having no troubles or suffering or enemies and one that results when all our plans go the way we want. The peace of Jesus is a "fiery peace" that turns our world upside down when we give ourselves to him. When one definitively opts for Christ, it often goes against the grain of the world, causing rapture of relations. Yet, in the midst of all these, there is an undefinable, indescribable, unearthly peace that reigned the hearts of those holy souls. Christ offers such peace which can survive violence and death; not the short-lived, empty worldly peace that crumbles at the first instance of stress.

Question of the Week: How do you keep up your peace in the midst of daily challenges?

CHAPTER ONE: THE CHURCH'S MISSIONARY TRANSFORMATION

II. Pastoral activity and conversion

An ecclesial renewal which cannot be deferred

30. Each particular Church, as a portion of the Catholic Church under the leadership of its bishop, is likewise called to missionary conversion. It is the primary subject of evangelization,[30] since it is the concrete manifestation of the one Church in one specific place, and in it "the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church of Christ is truly present and operative".[31] It is the Church incarnate in a certain place, equipped with all the means of salvation bestowed by Christ, but with local features. Its joy in communicating Jesus Christ is expressed both by a concern to preach him to areas in greater need and in constantly going forth to the outskirts of its own territory or towards new sociocultural settings.[32] Wherever the need for the light and the life of the Risen Christ is greatest, it will want to be there.[33] To make this missionary impulse ever more focused, generous and fruitful, I encourage each particular Church to undertake a resolute process of discernment, purification and reform.




