

- Does my pride come before what is best for others or my family?
- Does my reliance on substances cause me to hurt others physically, mentally or psychologically?
- Am I using my God-given gifts for the flourishing of others or to pursue my own needs?
- What in my life causes me to sin?

Question of the Week: Where do I find myself in the examination of conscience above?

Our Lady of the Lake School Wall Project



Replacement of the north and west walls of Our Lady of the Lake School has been completed. The walls required replacement when *Building Restoration Corp* began tuck point work on the exterior bricks and discovered the north and west walls of the school were "free stand-

ing", that is, there was no reinforcement support system. The 4" block foundation and wall was replaced with 12" block including horizontal supports every four feet and vertical supports every eight feet. We thank *Quality Brick & Stone*, of Marengo, for the prompt completion of the project. The walls will cure over the winter with painting expected next spring. *Building Restoration Corp* continues their work on Our Lady of the Lake Church and School.

During restoration work the south entry doors of the church are closed. Please use the north entrance for access to the church or the south door between the church and school.


