## Father Jerome's Message ... Increase our Faith (Luke 17:5-10)

The disciples were not able to grasp everything that was going on around them. They were increasingly helpless in taking account of Jesus' teachings. What they got from Jesus wasn't a direct answer but answers within the lines and explanations thereafter.

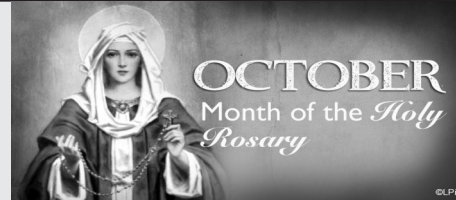
**The Public Square Rosary Rally**

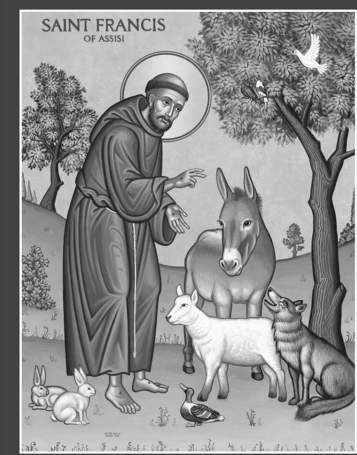
