Father Jerome's Message ... Increase our Faith (Luke 17:5-10)

The disciples were not able to grasp everything that was going on around them. They were increasingly helpless in taking account of Jesus' teachings. They wanted more help to go deeper into the spiritual realm in order to understand the present day workings. What they got from Jesus wasn't a direct answer but answers within the lines and explanations thereafter.

Faith should go beyond our challenges, thereby we would be able to overcome them. Secondly, our working should not be for rewards or appreciation but doing so with cheerfulness. We really need faith to see the reality as the Lord perceives. It is not in receiving but in giving that we are counted before God. It is the reversal of the consumeristic philosophy.

The message is simplified, while losing none of its depth and truth, and thus becomes all the more forceful and convincing.



> In case of rain the event will be held indoors at Our Lady of the Lake.


