Mark 10:49

We read Bartimaeus's story in the gospel. He was born blind. He knew his impediment of sight. He had been looking for a cure. He did not give up until he received what he hoped for.

Bartimaeus clearly was aware of Jesus of Nazareth. He shouted for help, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And no one could stop him from shouting until he reached Jesus' ears! Our prayers may look ignored at the first instance, but our continuous pleas do reach God. When a prayer comes from the heart of yourself, it will be answered by God.

When Bartimaeus reached Jesus, Jesus asks him, "What do you want me to do for you?" Bartimaeus made his request by saying, "Master, I want to see." Jesus' replies, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately Bartimaeus received his sight! His trust in Jesus made him well. It shows us that faith presupposes God's working in our lives. Do not complain that God does not hear our prayers or looks into our needs. What matters is our faith; our trust in Him matters.

Today, you can see; you can hear; you can think; you can walk; you can feel and touch. Are you on the right path that leads to the Kingdom of heaven? How do you make use of your God given faculties and opportunities to come closer to God? If not, come to Jesus, he will open up your eyes.

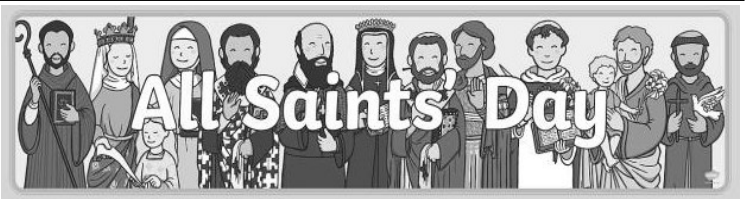
