

Father Jerome's Message ... The True King (Luke 23:35-43)

In the narrative of Jesus' temptations in the desert, we are told that the devil "departed from him until an opportune time"

(Lk 4:13). One of the crucial occasions wherein the tempter revisits Jesus, in far more disguised and subtler form, is while he is on the cross: the temptation comes in and through the voice of the crowd around him – the people, the soldiers, and even one of the criminals crucified with him – who jeer him and ask him to prove himself as the King by coming down from the cross. This temptation is not different from that in the desert where the tempter, far more directly, asked him to jump off the pinnacle of the Jerusalem Temple to prove himself to be the Son of God. Jesus refused then; he refuses now as well. For, his kingdom is not one of grandiose spectacles at the service of oneself, nor is his kingdom to prove anything before anyone: His Kingship, and thereby his Kingdom, is all about making oneself vulnerable and powerless for the sake of love, a kenosis (self-emptying) unto death in order to give life to others (cf. Phil 2:5-11). Therefore, in refusing to throw himself down and thereby save him, Jesus proves to be the true King.



Faith always remains something of a cross; it retains a certain obscurity which does not detract from the firmness of its assent. Some things are understood and appreciated only from the standpoint of this assent, which is a sister to love, beyond the range of clear reasons and arguments. We need to remember that all religious teaching ultimately has to be reflected in the teacher's way of life, which awakens the assent of the heart by its nearness, love and witness.




