Evangelii Gaudium (The Joy of the Gospel) is a 2013 apostolic exhortation by Pope Francis "On the proclamation of the Gospel in today's world."

3. I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since "no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord".^[1] The Lord does not disappoint those who take this risk; whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that he is already there, waiting for us with open arms. Now is the time to say to Jesus: "Lord, I have let myself be deceived; in a thousand ways I have shunned your love, yet here I am once more, to renew my covenant with you. I need you. Save me once again, Lord, take me once more into your redeeming embrace". How good it feels to come back to him whenever we are lost! Let me say this once more: God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking his mercy. Christ, who told us to forgive one another "seventy times seven" (Mt 18:22) has given us his example: he has forgiven us seventy times seven. Time and time again he bears us on his shoulders. No one can strip us of the dignity bestowed upon us by this boundless and unfailing love. With a tenderness which never disappoints, but is always capable of restoring our joy, he makes it possible for us to lift up our heads and to start anew. Let us not flee from the resurrection of Jesus, let us never give up, come what will. May nothing inspire more than his life, which impels us onwards!

Meet Sister Roselyn, Heil, FSPA, the newest member of our staff...

As I settle into my new home here in Ashland, WI, I am in awe of the beautiful open welcome. Thank you. It is good to be back and walk the halls of St. Agnes, I mean Our Lady of the Lake School and Church. I was here back in 1975 for my student teaching in the middle grades. I get ahead of myself.

I grew up on a farm south of Marathon City, WI, setting my roots deep into the land, alongside my Dad, feeding cows and gathering from Earth her gifts of food and medicine. Mom taught us the gifts of herbs and flowers. I learned a diversity of ways of doing things from my eight sisters and three brothers, as well as the peace and energy which comes through compromise. And yes, that included what Jesus taught us in the power of forgiveness to ourselves and others. These discoveries in life all began with pushing my twin sister, Carolyn, into this world on June 20, 1949.

My family was taught by the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration, (FSPA) from La Crosse, WI. Inspired by the FSPA's, Carolyn and I joined them after high school and made first vows in 1970. Working in a parish in Milwaukee, as the Liturgy Director, inspired me to seek my Masters in Culture and Creation-Centered Spirituality. It was the opportunity to discover the language of an ever expanding experience of God with us, through us and all around us. This learning experience gave me the framework and space to delve into my indigenous roots including the gift of storytelling. It also opened me to the opportunities to discover the journey into God's cathedrals, working as a National Park Ranger Naturalist in the parks around the country. Naturalist John Muir, 1838-1914, gave me the acceptable language in a public forum to share how everything is connected to everything in One Body (of Christ).

Aware of the hurting of people around me, I embarked on the chaplaincy journey bringing me back to Wisconsin and my FSPA roots. I worked at Marywood Spirituality Center in Woodruff, WI and Lac du Flambeau Indian Reservation. Most recently this took me to Bell Tower Assisted Living as chaplain. All these diverse opportunities continually prepare me for the next step of my journey of life which brings me back to Ashland and Odanah. I am excited about the new possibilities and discoveries with you. Thank you for your gentle and tender welcoming along with continual prayers for my family as our mother and sister journeyed into eternal life recently.


SDCCW Mary Jane Morancyk Hennessy Scholarships
