# Father Jerome's Message ... Proclaimers of the Good News

(Luke 10:1-12, 17-20)

Jesus sending seventy-two others employs the best strategy for evangelization. The sharing of Good News is not just Jesus alone, but uses the generosity of His disciples. Jesus was limited in space and time while He was doing his public ministry. He shared our human nature in everything. He shared His joy with His disciples, and they shared it widely.

When the disciples returned to Jesus, they were exuberant and rejoicing. Jesus listened to their stories. Since they carried the 'Heavenly Mission,' they could win over the evil spirits and do many great things. What a satisfying mission it was for His disciples!

Today, Jesus invites you to proclaim the Good News in your family, neighborhood, friends and community at large. You are a witness when you speak about Jesus, great things happen. How willing are you to continue His mission? Jesus promises us the great reward that "your names are written in heaven."

### CHAPTER ONE: THE CHURCH'S MISSIONARY TRANSFORMATION

### I. A Church which goes forth

Taking the first step, being involved and supportive, bearing fruit and rejoicing

24. ...It is familiar with patient expectation and apostolic endurance. Evangelization consists mostly of patience and disregard for constraints of time. Faithful to the Lord's gift, it also bears fruit. An evangelizing community is always concerned with fruit because the Lord wants her to be fruitful. It cares for the grain and does not grow impatient at the weeds. The Sower when he sees weeds sprouting among the grain does not grumble or overreact. He or she finds a way to let the word take flesh in a particular situation and bear fruits of new life, however imperfect or incomplete these may appear. The disciple is ready to put his or her whole life on the line, even to accepting martyrdom, in bearing witness to Jesus Christ, yet the goal is not to make enemies but to see God's word accepted and its capacity for liberation and renewal revealed. Finally an evangelizing community is filled with joy; it knows how to rejoice always. It celebrates every small victory, every step forward in the work of evangelization. Evangelization with joy becomes beauty in the liturgy, as part of our daily concern to spread goodness. The Church evangelizes and is herself evangelized through the beauty of the liturgy, which is both a celebration of the task of evangelization and the source of her renewed self-giving.

God our Father, giver of life, we entrust the United States of America to your loving care. You are the rock on which this nation was founded. You alone are the true source of our cherished rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Reclaim this land for your glory and dwell among your people.


