

Father Jerome's Message...Fifth Sunday of Lent

Lenten Mission: The Journey to Jerusalem

We began our Lenten journey with the marking of ashes to remind us of our mortality and to repent and believe in the Gospel. From that initiation we followed Jesus into the desert to confront the temptations that draw us away from Christ. On the Second Sunday, we accompanied Jesus up the mountain to see him transfigured as God's "Beloved Son." On the Third Sunday, we joined the disciples as they traveled through Samaria where Jesus met a disgraced woman at the well, who proclaimed Him to the townsfolk as the Messiah. On the Fourth Sunday, we witnessed Jesus' curing the man born blind who's trust in Jesus was challenged by the authorities. On this Fifth Sunday, Jesus raises his friend Lazarus from the dead before entering Jerusalem for the last time. Each of these points along our journey with Jesus to Jerusalem challenge our belief and trust in Christ to transform us into his image, despite our past sins, blindness, or deadness to his call. On Palm Sunday, we begin Holy Week with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Holy Week is the most sacred week of the liturgical year, a time when we enter Jerusalem with Jesus and are called to join him in his passion, death, and resurrection. This Sunday's session is intended to help us to prepare for that final stage of our journey to Jerusalem and be transformed – to be reborn in the dying and rising of Christ to new life so that we become beacons of God's Kingdom in our midst -to become living witnesses of Christ's risen Body, the Eucharist present in our troubled world.


CHAPTER TWO: AMID THE CRISIS OF COMMUNAL COMMITMENT

60. Today's economic mechanisms promote inordinate consumption, yet it is evident that unbridled consumerism combined with inequality proves doubly damaging to the social fabric. 

FAMILY OF FAITH: Resurrection Gardens

The photos below show Family of Faith participants planting Resurrection Gardens at the beginning of Lent. A resurrection garden is a recreation of Jesus' burial tomb. The garden is created using a flat dish, a clay pot to create the tomb, dirt, stones, moss, grass seeds and other small plants to create the scene of Christ's tomb. As families journey through Lent and Holy Week, small crosses can be added to the garden for Good Friday and a stone can be placed in front of the tomb. Children will gently water the seeds of the garden to allow the garden to spring to new life with the growth of the grasses and plants. On Easter Sunday, the stone is rolled away from the tomb to represent Jesus' resurrection and the tomb is surrounded by new life of the growing grasses and plants. The resurrection garden is a tangible reminder of the new life we celebrate in Jesus' resurrection.

USCCB Encourages HHS to Strengthen Conscience Rule

The U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) has proposed new changes to regulations meant to protect conscience rights in health care. Let HHS know that conscience matters to you!

Numerous federal laws protect the right of organizations and people working in health care to object, as a matter of conscience, to abortion, sterilization, assisted suicide, gender transition surgery, and other procedures. The enforcement of these conscience objection laws are governed by HHS regulations.


HHS has proposed revisions to these regulations, known as the "Conscience Rule," which implements over a dozen conscience statutes. Under the Trump administration, HHS issued a strong version of the Conscience Rule, but courts struck it down, leaving in place the previous, extremely weak version from the Obama administration. On January 5, 2023, HHS proposed

The USCCB and the WCC support this new proposed rule as an improvement over the 2019 Rule which is currently in place, but also urges HHS to strengthen the proposed rule. Individuals are encouraged to contact HHS in support of strengthening the Conscience Rule


