## Father Jerome's Message: Miraculous Feeding (*John 6:1-15*)

In our gospel from John, Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him. He said to Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" What a concern Jesus had for the crowd who were coming to him and going to stay with him. Jesus was concerned about the basic need for food, feeding the hungry before he did anything. When Jesus taught his disciples 'how to pray', He mentioned in this prayer to pray to His Heavenly Father – "Give us today our daily bread;" (Mt 6:11). Jesus provides the bread to the crowd who would otherwise miss their meal.

In our gospel from John, we hear of the miraculous feeding of the five thousand. While it is fine to focus on the loaves and fishes, we should keep in mind that John inserts many clues into his writing. Each passage in his gospel is like an escape room promising to give us entry into a deeper understanding of the mystery of our salvation; minute details point to other clues that unlock doors.

We who are members of his Mystical Body ought to take note of how Christ performs his roles of priest, prophet, and king in the gospels. Can we be a Body that gives thanks for the gifts we receive rather than complaining at every inconvenience?

**Question of the Week:** *How can you help to see that many are fed, in imitation of Jesus?*



### OUR LADY OF THE LAKE SUMMER BUILDING PROJECTS

Summer building projects continue around the campus of Our Lady of the Lake. Employees of *NASI Roofing* recently installed a high-quality flat roof system to replace the very aged roof of the school. With the improved heating system installed last year in the school, church and Pastoral Center, old heating system vents on the school roof were no longer needed and removed. Scuttles, used to remove or install large pieces of equipment from the school, were redone for easier access.

The next building project, scheduled to begin the first week of August, is masonry repair of the south side of the church. *Building Restoration Corp.* from Roseville, Minnesota, will be on site to repair and restore weathered and chemically damaged stonework.

3. You are directed to the site for Our Lady of the Lake. Tap "Amount" to fill in the donation amount. Or, scroll down and tap "View More Giving Opportunities" to direct funds to a specific cause.
3. Tap "Add to Basket"; and then tap "Continue to Payment"
4. Enter credit or debit card information and contact information.
5. Tap "Continue to Review"
6. Tap "Place Payment"

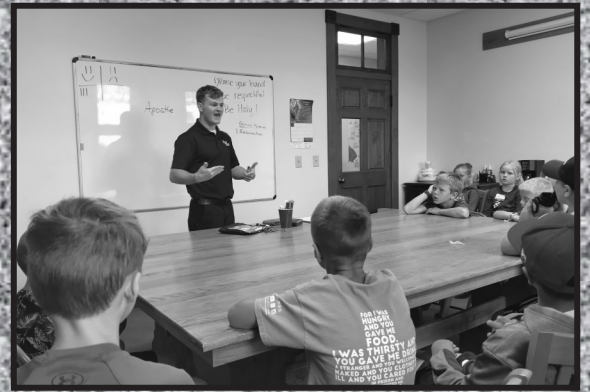


### Totus Tuus 2024
