VOCATIONS

Every parish needs a priest to shepherd and lead their community. Deacons are ordained ministers and important servants of the Church. It takes years of formation to become a priest or deacon, and a significant investment of time and money on this journey. Supporting the CSA helps ease the financial commitment of these faith leaders during their education and continuing formation. Our Diocese will be blessed to have three ordinations to the priesthood in June of 2023 and at least three more in seminary. Formation for each seminarian can cost over \$50,000 a year.


