PUBLIC NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING

PUBLIC HEARING CITY OF HAMLET – COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG-NR) PROGRAM

Notice is hereby given that the Hamlet City Council will hold a Special Meeting on Wednesday, September 30, 2026, at 5 pm at Hamlet City Hall, 201 Main Street, Hamlet, NC 28345, to consider a proposed grant application under the 2026 North Carolina Community Development Block Grant – Neighborhood Revitalization (CDBG-NR) Program.

The purpose of this Special Meeting is to hold a public hearing to obtain citizen views and input regarding local housing and community development needs, and to present the specific details of the proposed project prior to application submission to the North Carolina Department of Commerce.

The City of Hamlet intends to submit an application requesting \$265,515.30 in CDBG-NR funding. In this capacity, the City of Hamlet will serve as the fiduciary unit of local government and grantee for the project subrecipient, Doc Hill's Family Care Home, Inc.

Proposed Project Scope & Activities:

- Scope of Work: Implementation of an 11-component facility improvement project, including structural repairs, accessibility enhancements, HVAC updates, security measures, and groundskeeping upgrades to support residential care and supportive services for low- and moderate-income (LMI) individuals.
- Total Requested Grant Amount: \$265,515.30

All citizens, particularly low- and moderate-income residents and individuals residing in the target neighborhood, are encouraged to attend and participate. Citizens will be given an opportunity to provide oral or written comments concerning the proposed project.
