SAFETY TIPS FOR THIS HOLIDAY SEASON

POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Beware of your surroundings entering/exiting Set up fryers on flat, non-flammable surfaces your car/store
- Secure your items by locking your vehicle
- Keep your valuables (purse) nearby and secure
- Stick with known retailers, beware of scams

- Use caution when approached by an unknown subject.
- Always call 911 if you are in danger

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- outdoors
- Know where you parked, park in well-lit areas Do not overfill pot with oil, pots should have a fill
 - Make sure turkey is completely thawed water & oil do not mix
 - Have a fire extinguisher close by and NEVER use water on oil fire
 - Water live Christmas trees
 - Be careful with space heaters and don't put close to combustibles
 - Have chimneys inspected/swept
