TRASH PICK-UP:

Service

For all service-related issues, questions, or concerns, please contact the City of Hamlet Public Works 910-582-7987 directly. They are your primary point of contact for scheduling, billing inquiries, missed pickups, and any other service matters.

Issue Resolution Process

When questions or concerns arise regarding your trash service, we maintain an extensive review system. All our trucks are equipped with cameras, and we will always review the footage to investigate and resolve any concerns or discrepancies. This ensures accurate and fair resolution of service issues.

Pickup Day Requirements

IMPORTANT: Trash cans must be rolled out to your designated pickup spot the NIGHT BEFORE your scheduled pickup day. This is crucial to ensure your trash gets collected on schedule. Cans placed out on the morning of pickup may be missed. Occasionally due to circumstances

HOLIDAY TRASH PICK-UP SCHEDULE:

- Tuesday, December 23rd will be picked up on Monday, December 22nd
- Wednesday, December 24th will be picked up on Tuesday, December 23rd
- Thursday, December 25th will be picked up on Friday, December 26th along with the businesses
