SECTION II: Petitions must be accompanied by a map showing all property lines, existing buildings and present zoning classifications of all adjacent property. The petition must also be accompanied by a list of names and mailing addresses of each landowner and number of the lot they own. This information may be obtained from the Richmond County Tax Assessor's Office.

SECTION III. Any petition presented to support this request must be prepared on specific forms provided by the City of Hamlet.

SECTION IV. The petitioners do hereby agree to pay a filing cost of **\$500.00** upon the presentation of this petition to the Hamlet Zoning Administrator to cover administrative and advertising costs for a public hearing. The Planning Board will review the petition and make a recommendation to the Hamlet City Council. At a public hearing, usually scheduled for the regular meeting of the City Council, Council will hear the public's comments on the question and make a final decision.

SECTION V. If any information presented on this petition is found to be incorrect or incomplete, the Hamlet Planning Board or the Hamlet City Council may declare this petition void and require that a new petition be filed. All signatures and land ownership will be verified by tax records. **If a lot is owned by more than one person; both must sign the petition. Example:** Husband and wife must sign if both are listed as the owners. The landowner **must** sign. No one can sign for someone else.
