





ACTIVITY & PERFORMANCE REVIEW

ARIMM's committees together with MARIM's support staffs have organised several workshops and meetings to develop and enhance the training modules since 2019. These workshop are crucial to ensure the training materials meet the current market standard. ARIMM wants to be the best leading organisation that provide and offer risk management training in Malaysia.



Development of Training Modules

As an effort to elevate the professionalism of risk practitioners in Malaysia, MARIM has approved the establishment of The Academy of Risk Management Malaysia. The Academy will be the body that offers training and gives award for professional designation in risk management.

The training modules went rigorous quality process. At initial stage two universities were commissioned to develop syllabus for the modules based on the intended learning outcomes set by the Board of the Academy. Then, the syllabus were reviewed by risk practitioners in a workshop organized on 19 December 2018 at Sheraton, Petaling Jaya. The review were done through a focus group discussion led by Dr Arpah Abu Bakar from UUM and Dr Rabihah Md Sum from USIM.


The revised syllabus were used as a basis for course content development.

The content development tasks were assigned to the Academy Committee members. The contents were presented at the first batch certification workshop whereby the content were open for debates.

The revised course content were given to to the 2nd batch workshop participants to be further reviewed and improved. Again the course content were presented and debated by the participants who are industry leaders in risk management field. The course content were revised with the intention to be given to the appointed module developer.


ARIMM exercised an open tender for the module content development. However, the board decided to proceed with several phases of development to be done by the current member experts as the quotation was too high.

The Process in Training Module Development




Test Item Development Workshop

As part of the certification program, the ARiMM Committee on Technical and Certification organized Test Item Development workshop to provide training on developing assessments that are of the highest quality, accurately measure the necessary knowledge and skills, and are fair to all test takers.
