

ACTIVITIES AND PERFORMANCE REVIEW

⊕ 4th Annual General Meeting

ARIMM held its 4th Annual General Meeting (AGM) on May 23, 2024, at the ARIMM Office, Unit 610, Level 6, Block B, Pusat Dagangan Phileo Damansara 1, Jalan 16/11 off Jalan Damansara, 46350 Petaling Jaya, Selangor. The meeting was attended by a quorum of 22 members, with 12 participating by proxy and 10 attending in person.

The meeting commenced at approximately 10:00 a.m. with a welcoming address by the Chairman, En. Mohamad Bin Mohamad Zain. En. Mohamad expressed his gratitude to the Board of Directors and Members for attending the AGM in person, demonstrating their ongoing support and commitment to ARiMM. Mr. Chairman then introduced the attendees and extended his thanks to the Company Secretary, Mr. Satvinder Singh Gill, and the Auditor from Messrs. Ahmad Mustapha & Co., who were also present at the meeting.

The proposed agenda for the 4th AGM was approved by the members and accepted for deliberation. Pn. Nuranisah binti Mohd Anis proposed the motion to approve and adopt the 2023 Annual Report, and was seconded by Dr. Mohd Taipor bin Suhadah.

In accordance with Clause 59 of the Company's Constitution, three Directors, including Mohd Taipor bin Suhadah, Dzulkifly bin Mohd Yusof, and Anuar bin Abdul Shukur, retired. The retiring Directors expressed their intention to seek for a re-election to the Board of ARIMM. Ranjit Singh A/L Taram Singh proposed the motion, which was seconded by En. Abdul Halim bin Jantan. The re-election of the Directors was subsequently approved.

Pn. Azlina binti Zulkifli voluntarily resigned from her position as Director of ARiMM and was replaced by a new nomination and was subsequently appointed as a new Board Member, Dr. Zairol Azhar bin Auzzir. The motion for his appointment was proposed by En. Abdul Halim bin Jantan and seconded by Dr. Mohd Taipor bin Suhadah.

All members agreed to re-appoint Messrs. Ahmad Mustapha & Co. as the external auditor to independently examine and assess the financial statements of ARiMM for 2024, with their remuneration to be determined at a later time. The motion was proposed by Mr. Ranjit Singh A/L Taram Singh and seconded by Pn. Nuranisah binti Mohd Anis.

The 4th AGM adjourned its business at 10:50 a.m. following successful deliberations of all its agenda. The AGM recorded its appreciations and thanks to all members who had attended and actively participated in the meeting.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAMME

A total of six professional risk management certification programs were conducted in 2024.
