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Principal's Note

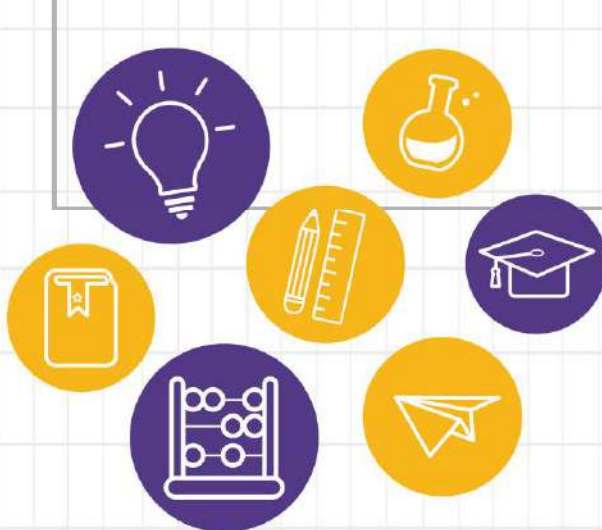
"Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today".

₹500 Grocery Challenge – Activity Description..

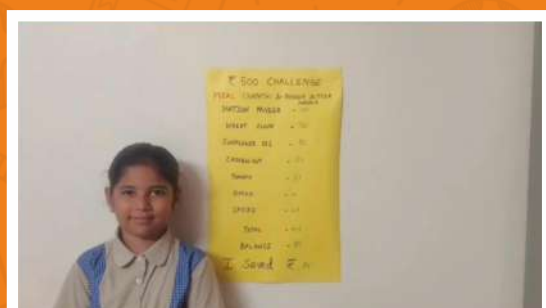
In this activity, our Grade 4 student learned the basics of personal finance through a fun ₹500 Grocery Challenge.

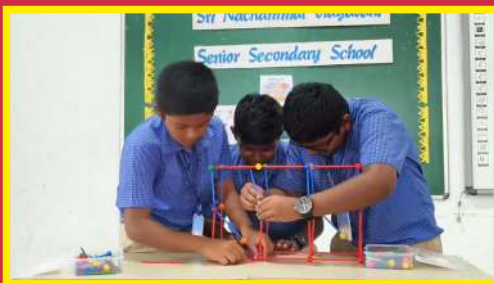

Think Before You Decide: The Confirmation Bias Court

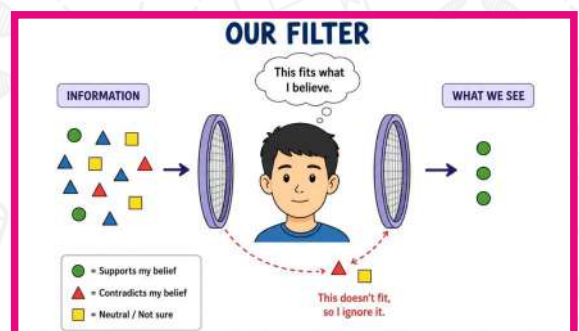
The Confirmation Bias Court activity was conducted by Ms. Shobana, CS Department, for Grade 9 students.

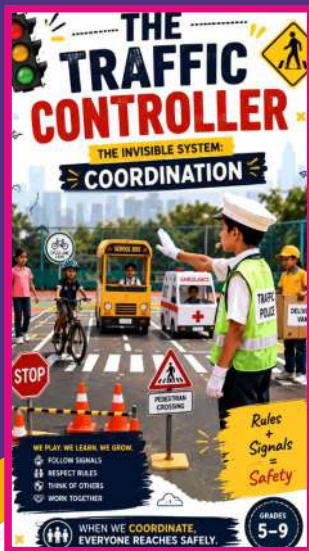
Traffic Controller – The Invisible Coordination
