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Principal's Note

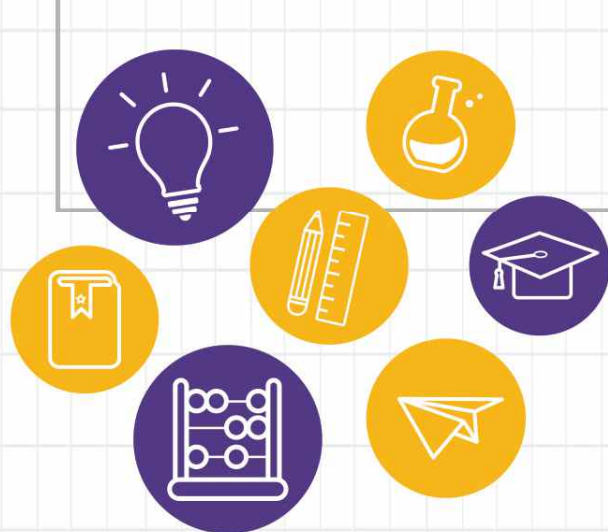
"Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today".

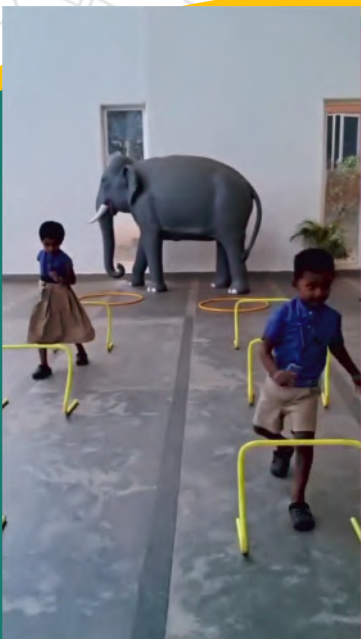
This memorable interaction encouraged and inspired all our students to believe in themselves, dream big, and aim for greater heights

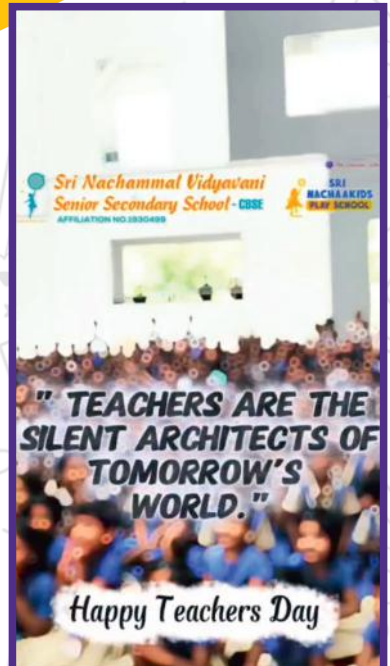
This heartfelt exchange not only enriched their personal libraries but also strengthened the bond of a reading community, making the day a memorable celebration of knowledge and kindness.

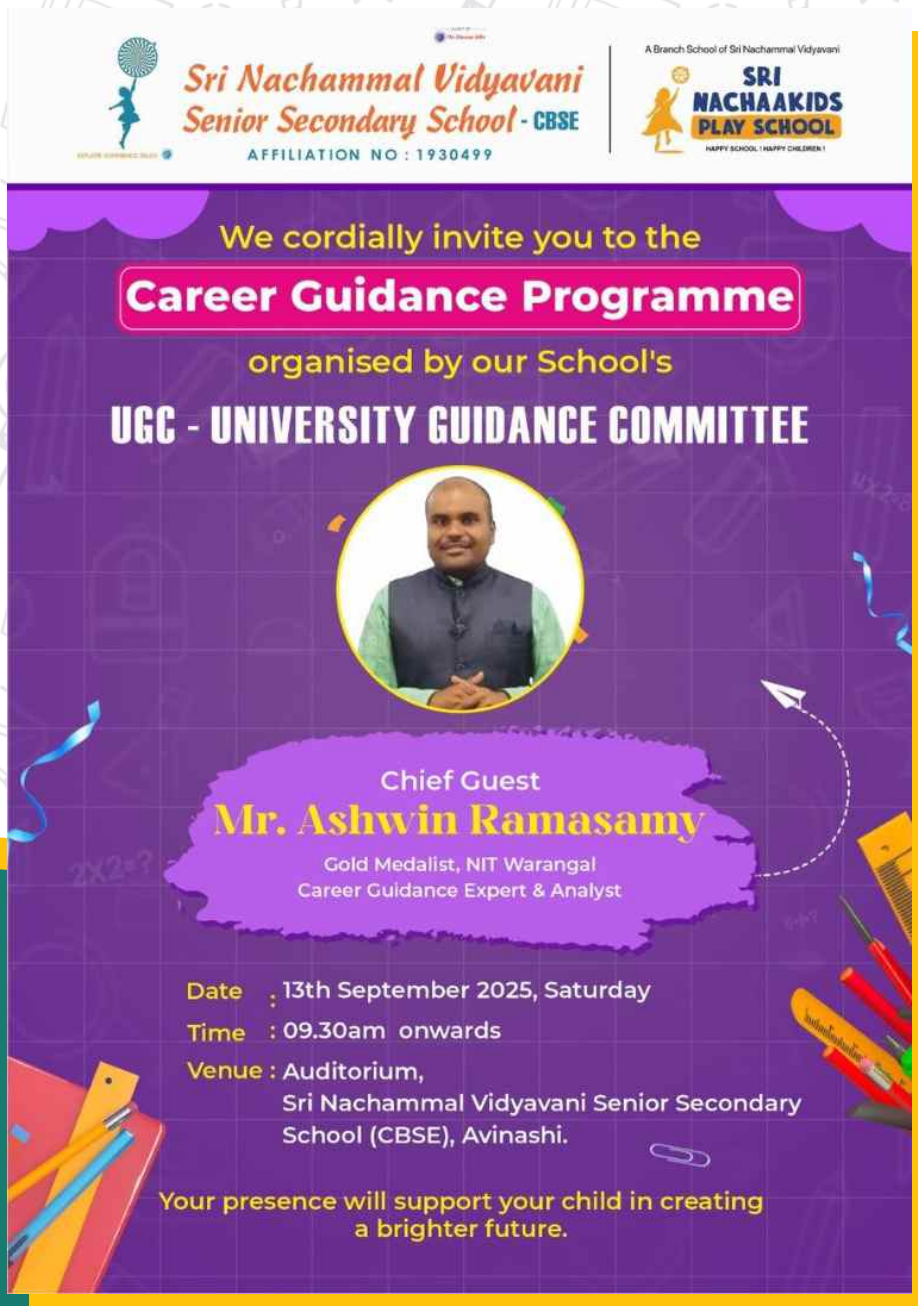
The session equipped the teachers with valuable strategies to effectively connect with and handle the unique needs of today's generation of students.

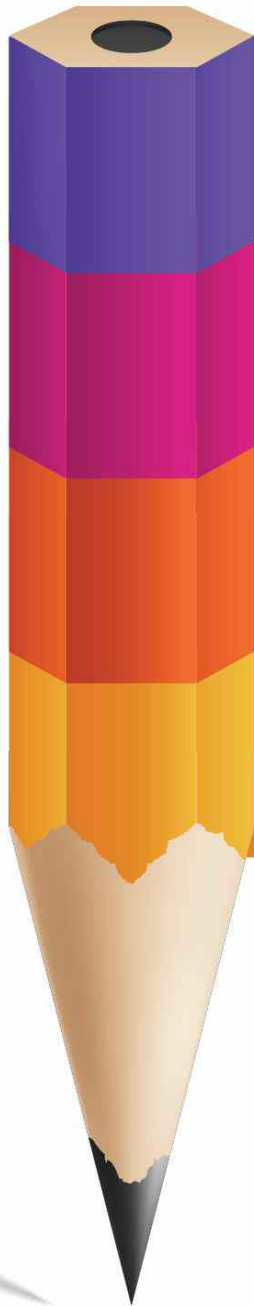
