




THE SYMPHONY OF MATH – ENRICH & EXPLORE

Truly it would be a memorable event for every child involved.




When Science Comes Alive – Exploring the Scattering of Light



This session was conducted as a meaningful tribute to Sir C. V. Raman, a man behind the scattering of light Science is fun when it's hands-on!





You Are the Santa – A Celebration of Giving & Kindness

Their happy smiles showed how much they loved discovering each bug!




Office Crew's Day Out
