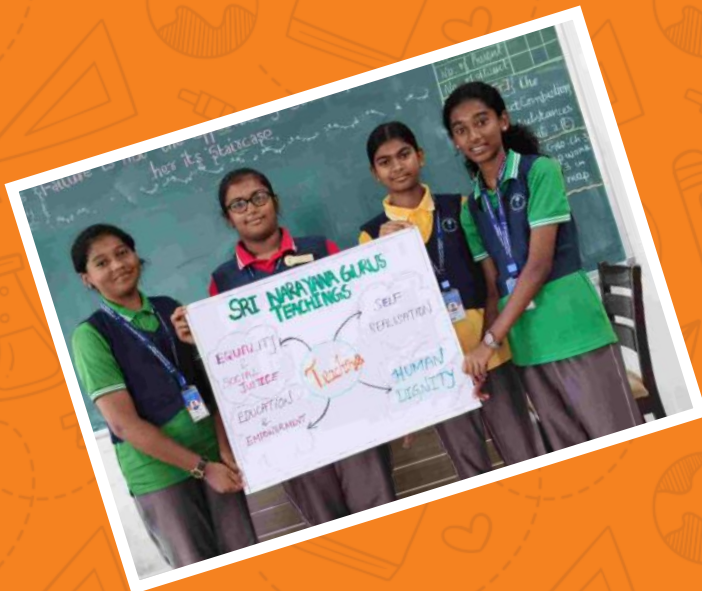

This activity helped them realize the power of small, thoughtful changes and how creativity can bring a big difference.



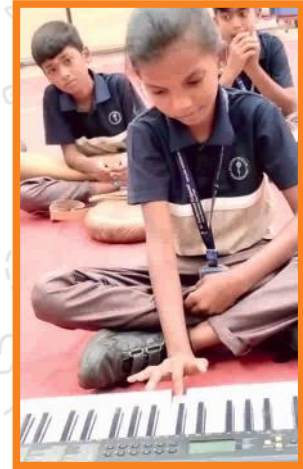
Talent Hunt Show 2025

The event also highlighted their creativity in art and art & craft , leaving everyone inspired and amazed.

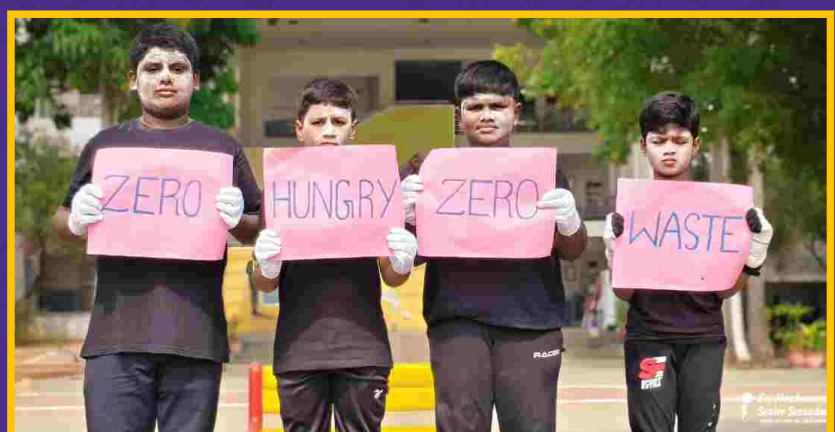
It was truly a day filled with energy, passion, and talent — celebrating the uniqueness of every child.

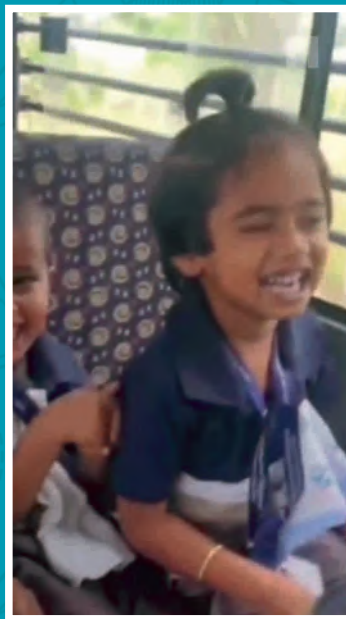
BEYOND BOUNDARIES: EDUCATIONAL EXPLORATIONS AND FIELDTRIP

Little Seniors Trekking Trip to Alagumalai - Tiny Feet, Big Adventures!

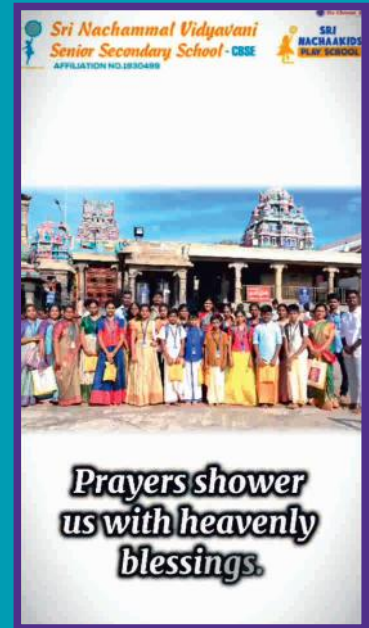
