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Principal's Note

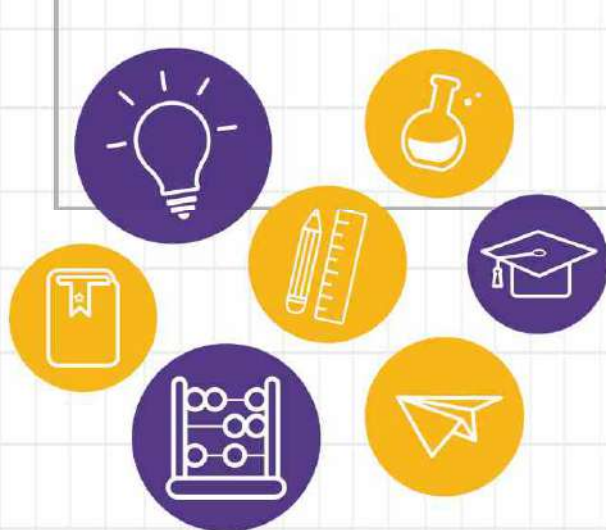
"Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today".

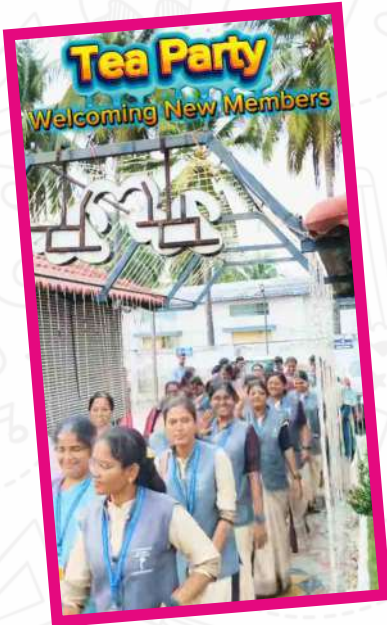
Overall, the activity successfully instilled values of empathy, responsibility, and democratic decision-making among the students.

Swirl to Rise: Topping it off with a little science magic!

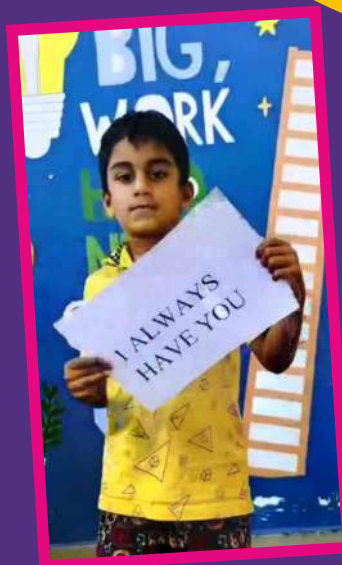
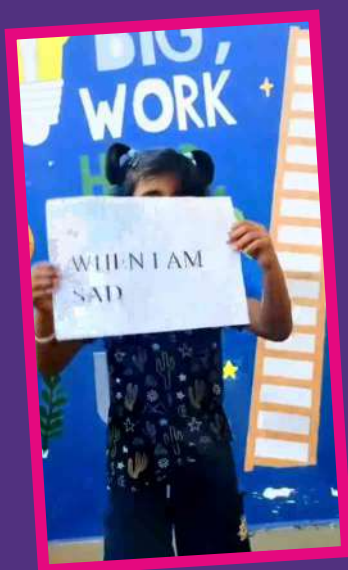
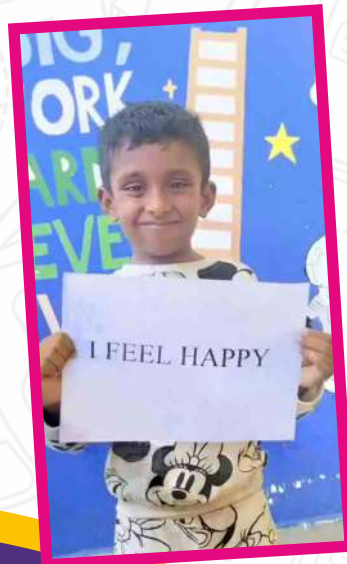

The session helped students:

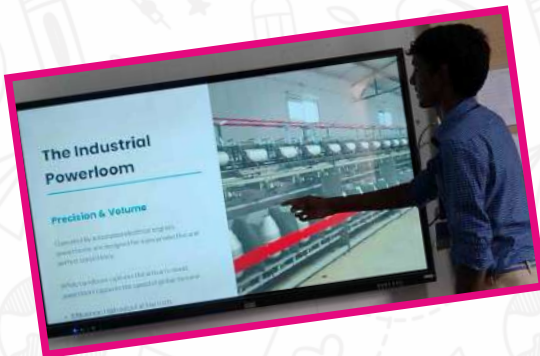
Understand the process of handloom and powerloom weaving

An engaging and enriching experience that blended knowledge, creativity, and practical understanding!



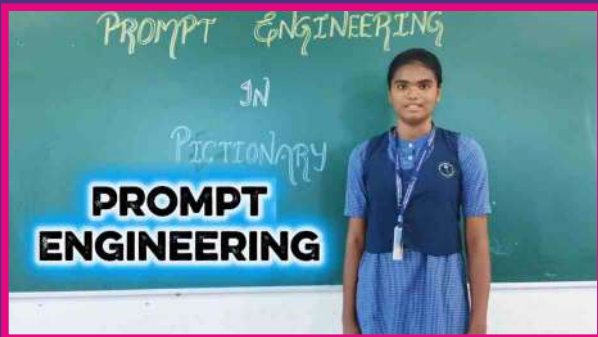
Mastering the Perfect Cover Drive!

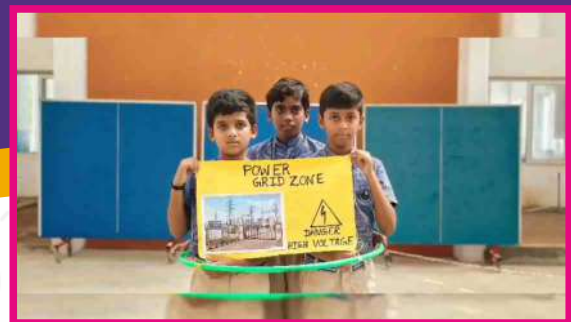
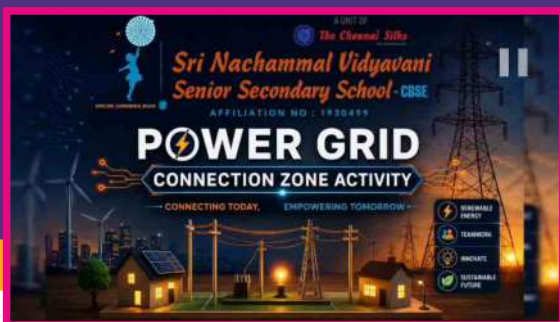
Learning Through Play!

Our enthusiastic Grade X-B students took initiative in conducting a Heat Safety Awareness drive under the guidance of Ms. Kavitha from Science Department.

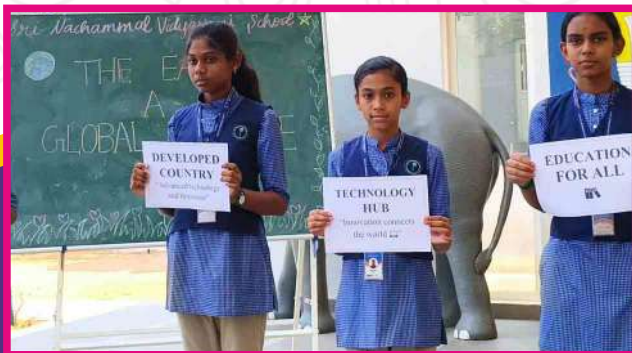
