Principal's Note

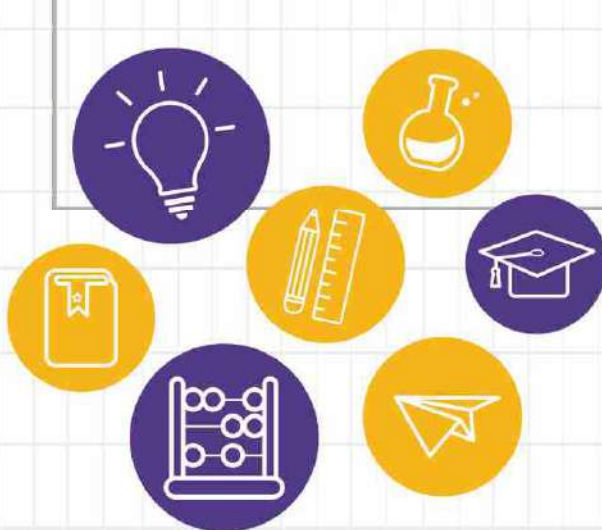
"Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today".

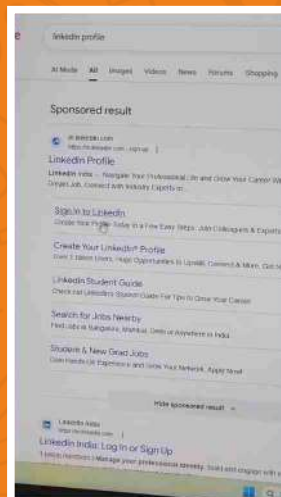


LEARNING ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

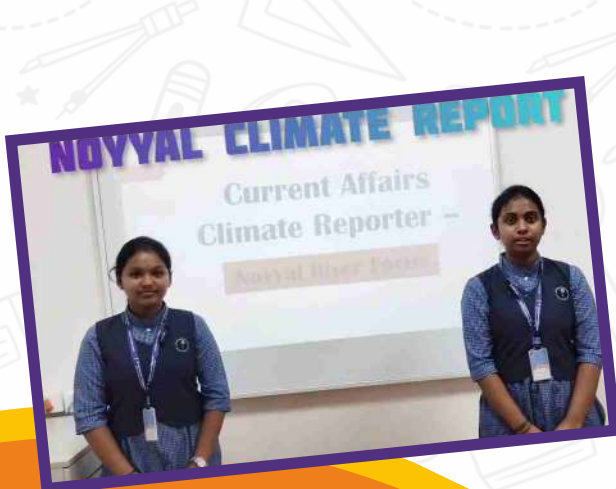


Exploring the Noyyal River

The activity was specially designed to help children understand why trimming their nails regularly is essential for maintaining healthy habits.

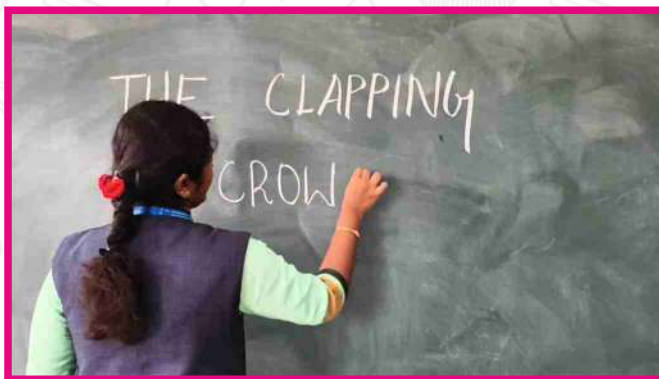


One Clap, Many Followers! | Grade 5 Learns the Power of Positive Influence

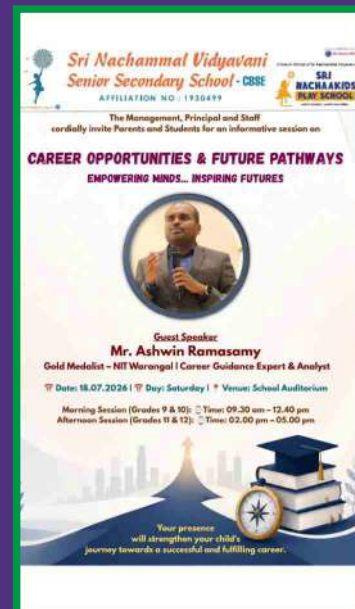
