Principal's Note

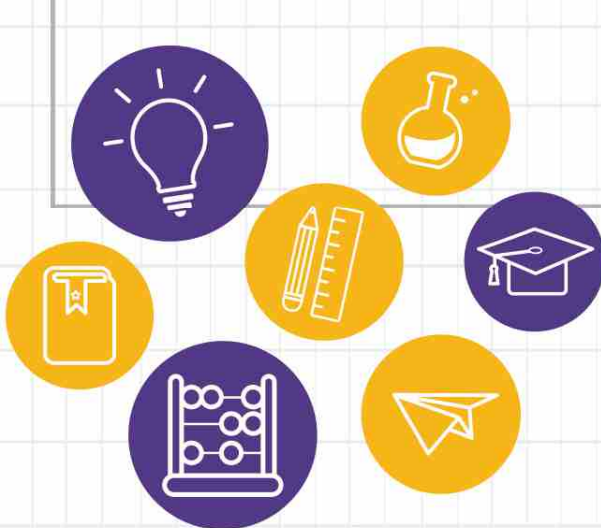

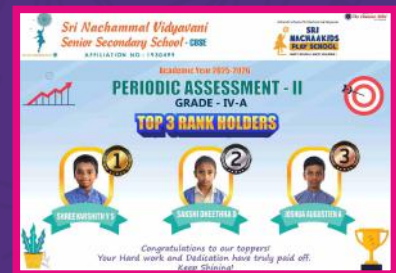


LEARNING ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

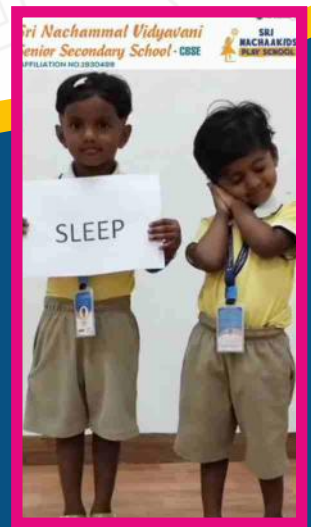
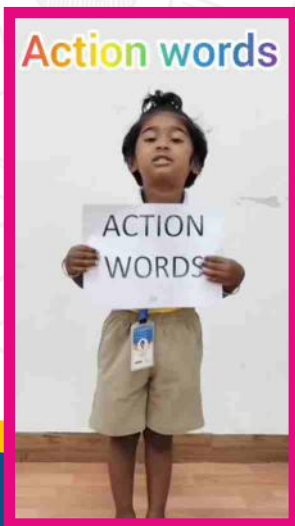

The session was meaningfully guided by Ms. Niranchana from our Computer Science Department, making the assembly informative, enjoyable, and inspiring for all.

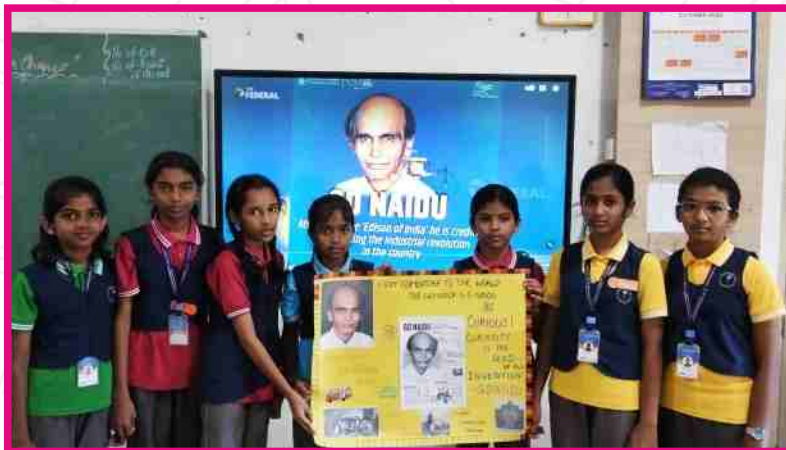


GD Naidu Innovation Activity – Grade 6

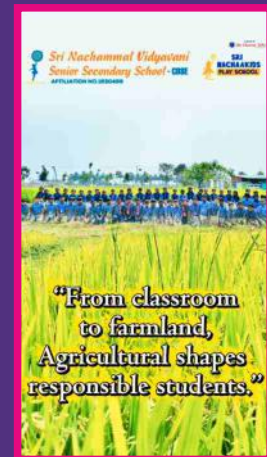
Experiential Learning at Rudram Farms – Grade 6 Field Visit
