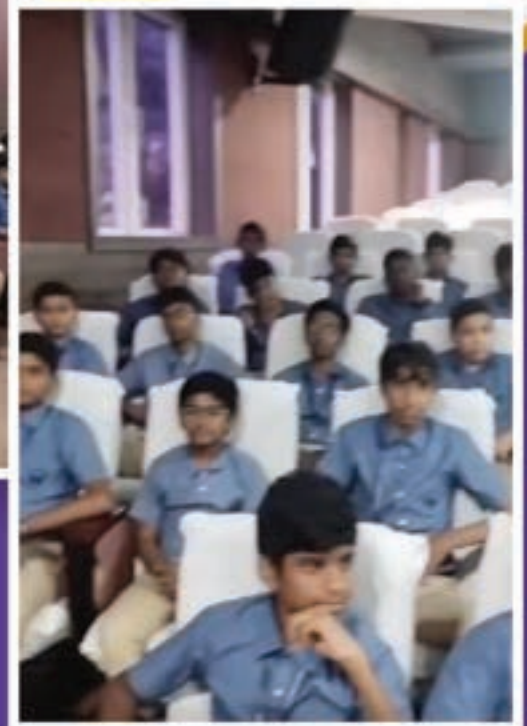
The session aimed to equip parents with tools and strategies to foster positive and supportive relationships with their teenage Children.

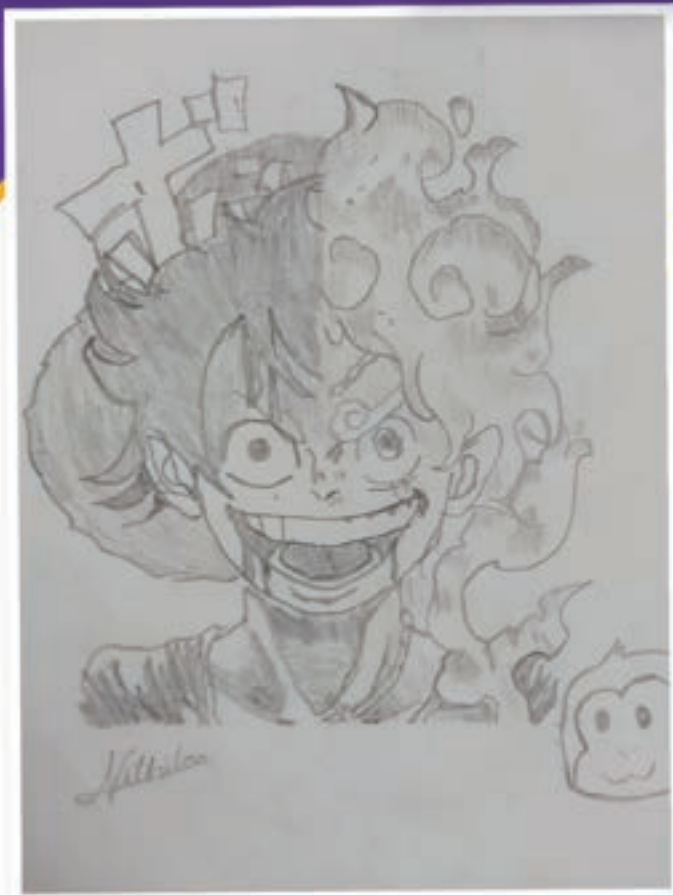
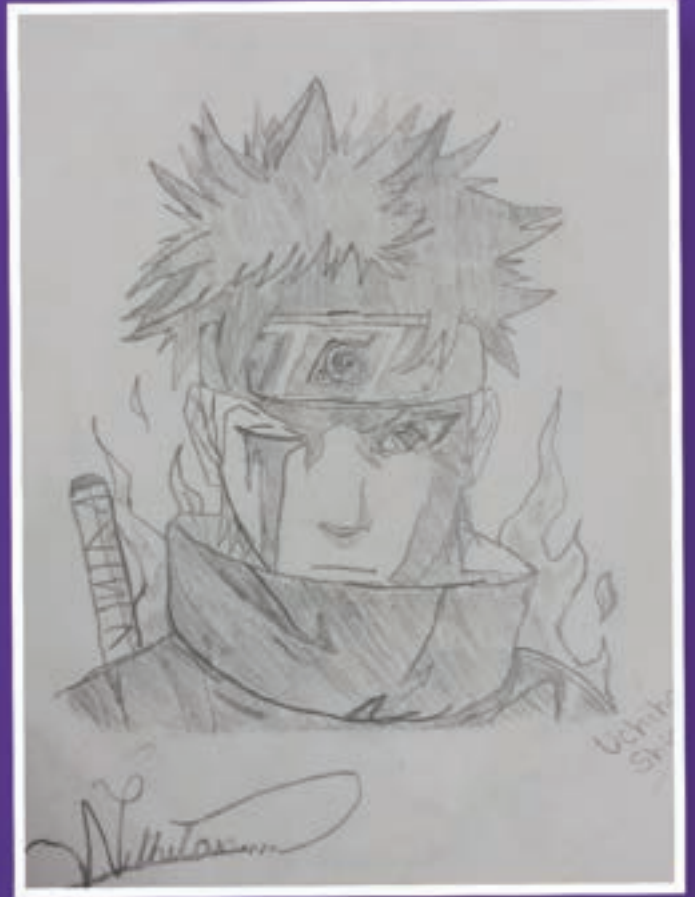


Inspiring Young Voices: Grade 5 Students Watch Greta Thunberg's Journey
