Showcasing our efforts and achievements in reducing carbon emissions through the use of solar energy within our school to meet our needs.

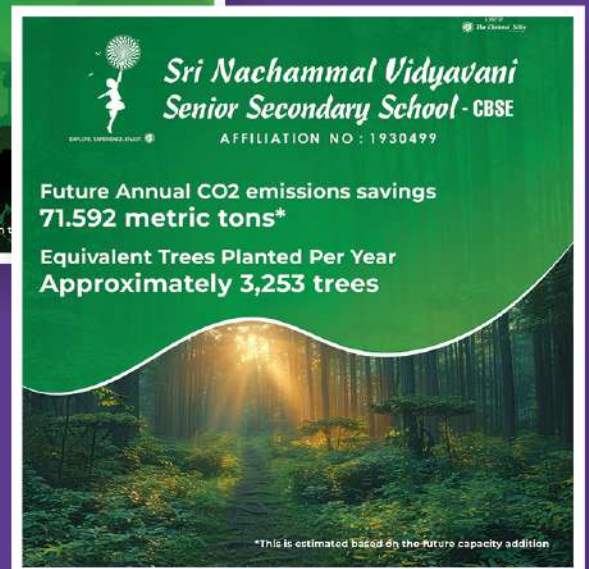

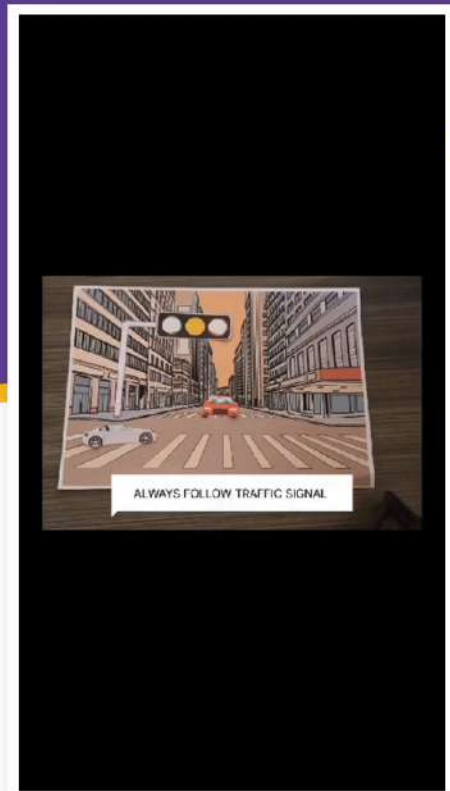

## Celebrating the 78th Independence Day with Pride and Patriotism

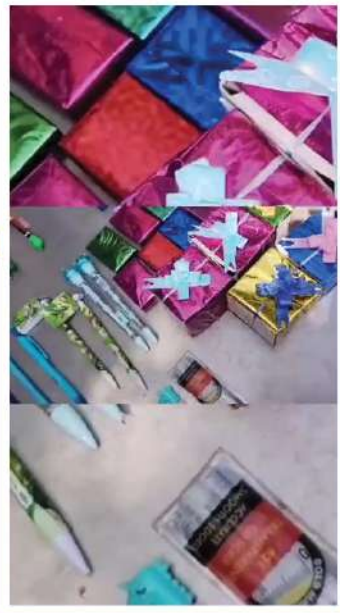

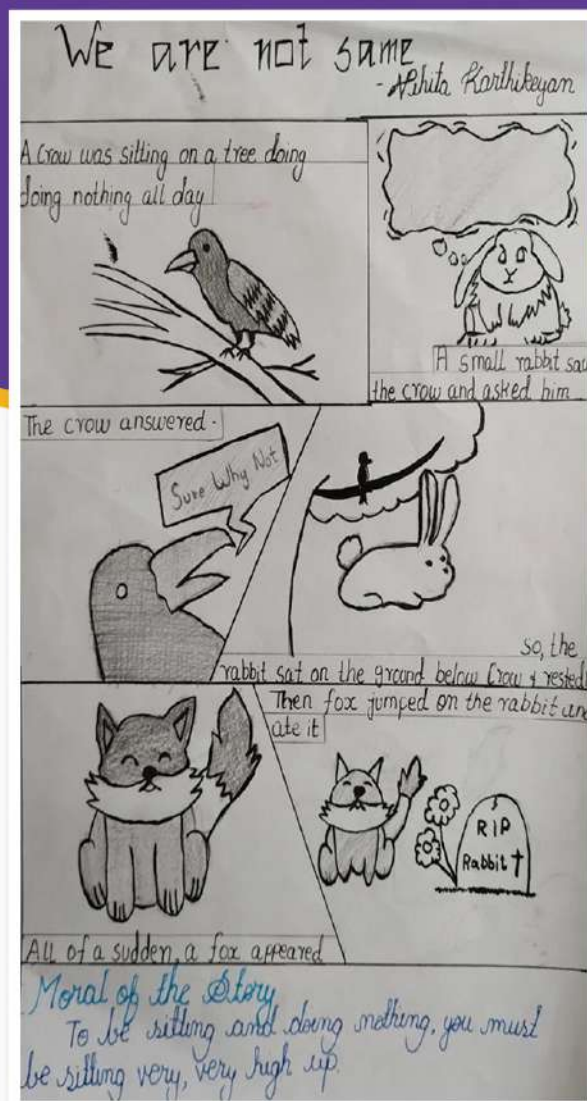


## Nikita Kartikeyan's Masterful Comic Strip: A Tale of Wisdom and Intrigue

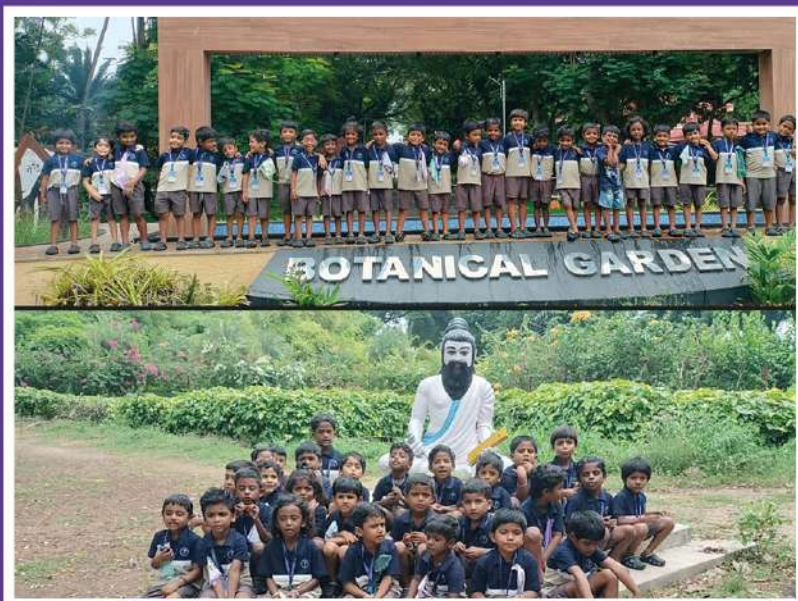

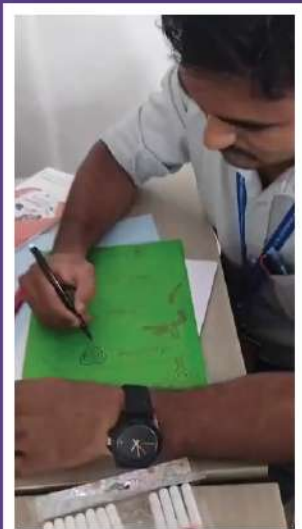
## Insightful Seminars: Empowering minds and Fostering Growth

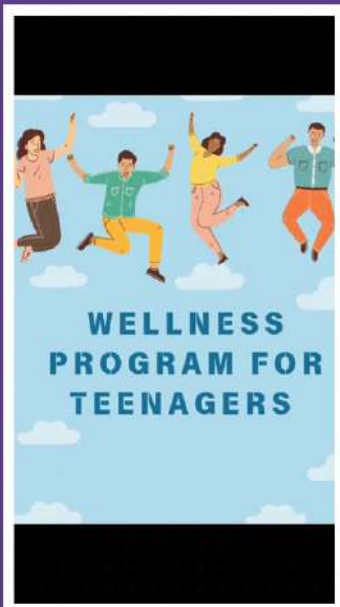

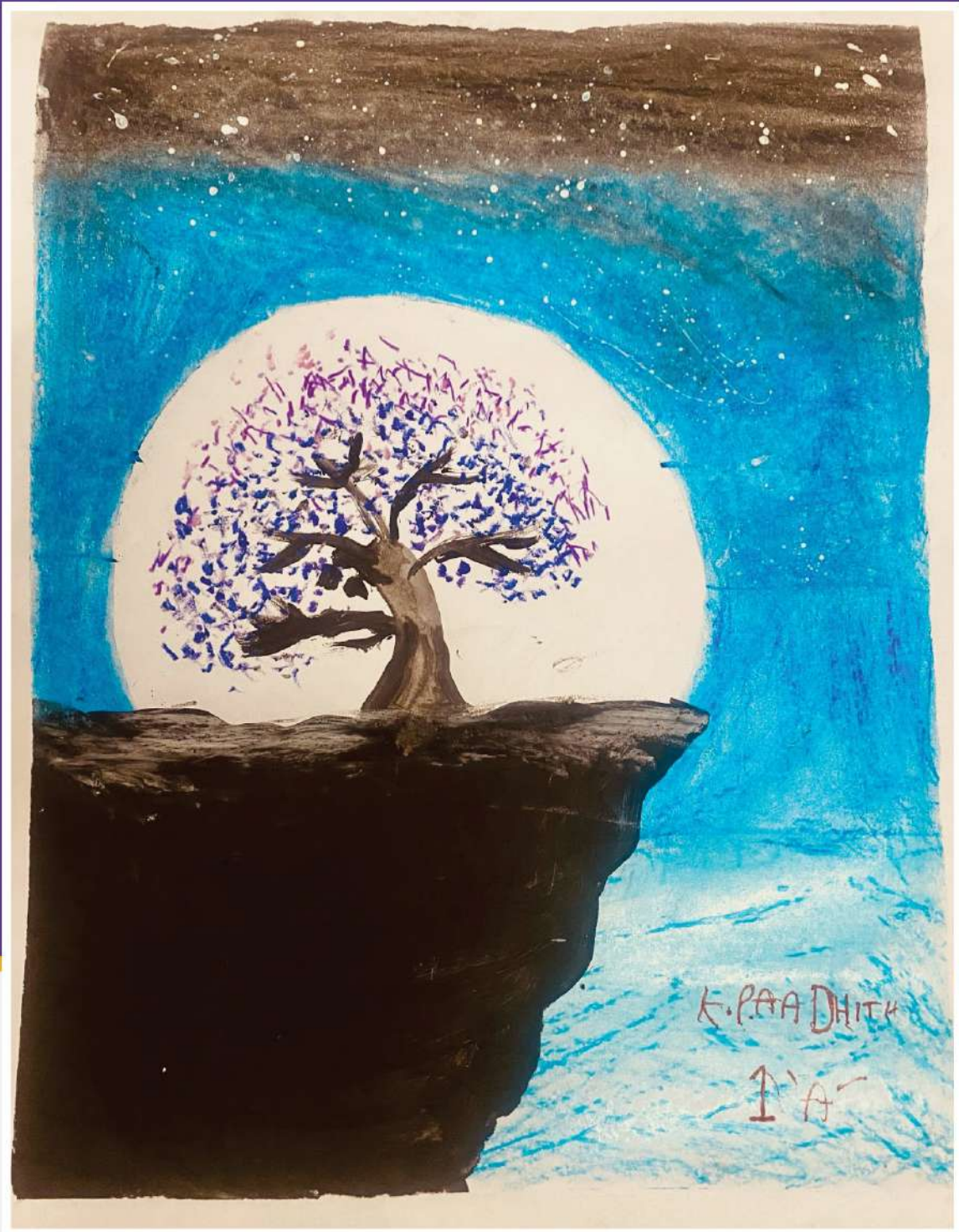
The certificate, printed on eco-friendly 100% recycled paper, underscores the school's contribution to a greener future.
