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# Principal's Note


"Education is the passport to the future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today".

# Weaving Creativity: Grade II Students Embrace String Figures on Global Day of Unplugging

Global Day of Unplugging, on this day Grade II students engaged in string figures activities. Through this activity, children learned the importance of engaging in non-digital activities, creating simple crafts, exploring traditional arts, and improving their fine motor skills.

This hands-on experience helps children to develop creativity, problem-solving abilities, and patience, which are essential skills for their overall development. Additionally, it encourages children to appreciate the value of unplugging from screens and enjoying real-world interactions.

#### .Empowering Athletes: Injury Prevention Awareness Session

Injuries are an unfortunate reality in sports, but with the right prevention program, athletes can significantly reduce their risk. To provoke awareness about injury prevention for sportsmen, we organised a session for Grades 6 to 10 students on the topic 'Injury Prevention' by Dr A.Periyasamy, Assistant Professor at Revathi Institute of Physiotherapy guided by Dr.T.S.Muthukumar, Principal of Revathi Institute of Physiotherapy and Research.

Our honourable speakers outlined key principles and strategies for developing effective injury prevention tailored as a presentation to athletes of all levels. He explained in detail the various types of injuries that happen during sports and elaborated on how they can be rectified/prevented.

He added that by implementing a structured injury prevention program that addresses individual risk factors and fosters a culture of prevention, athletes can minimize their risk of injury and stay healthy and competitive in their sport.

Students understand that prevention is always better than rehabilitation, so it is important to invest time and effort into proactive injury prevention strategies to keep themselves performing at their best.

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#### "Flight of Conservation: Grade IX C's Bird Sanctuary Endeavor"

Our students of Grade IX C designed a bird sanctuary, incorporating various features to attract and support local bird populations. They researched native bird species and their habitat requirements, including food sources, nesting preferences and plant diversity. Strategically placing feeders, nesting boxes and water sources, they created a welcoming environment for birds.

Additionally, students selected a variety of plants known to attract birds, such as flowering shrubs, fruit-bearing trees, and native grasses, enhancing biodiversity and ecological balance within the sanctuary. Through this project, students learnt about environmental stewardship, habitat conservation and the importance of preserving wildlife diversity.





#### Moonlight Memories: Strengthening Bonds in Grade 12

A moonlight day was organized for our students of grade 12 to strengthen the bond among them. They stayed in the school with their friends and teachers and had fun making memories through various games and freehand exercises.

Sathmika's Summer Bliss: Homemade Brown-Spotted Banana Milkshake


