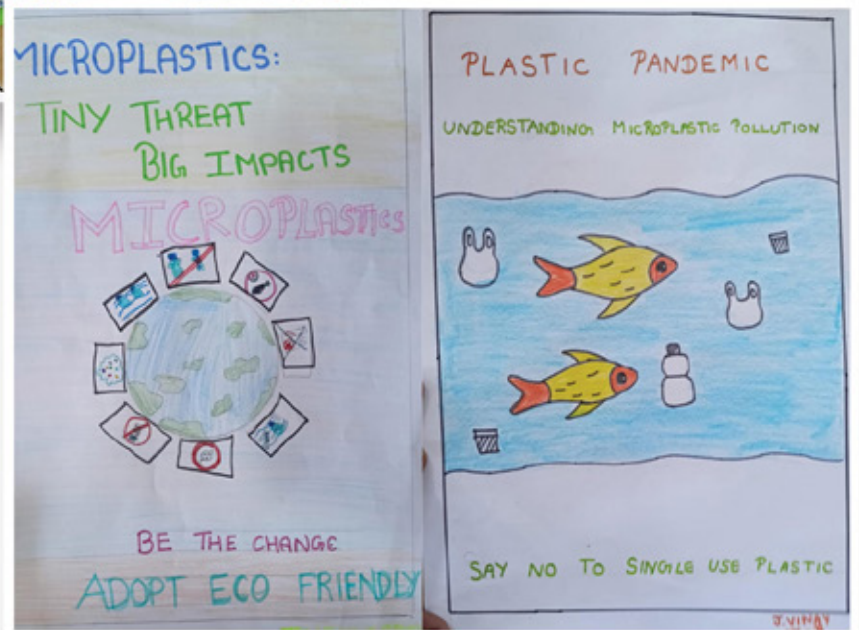
Making Waves on World Aquatic Day: Grade 7 Students Fight Microplastic Pollution

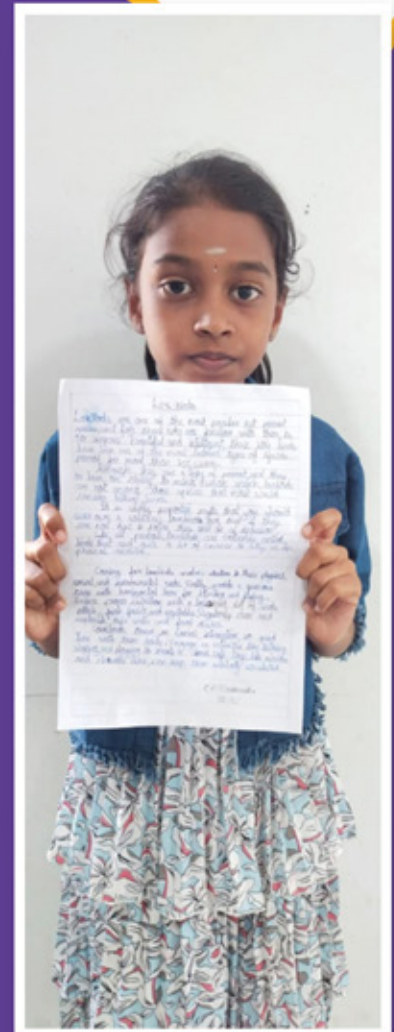
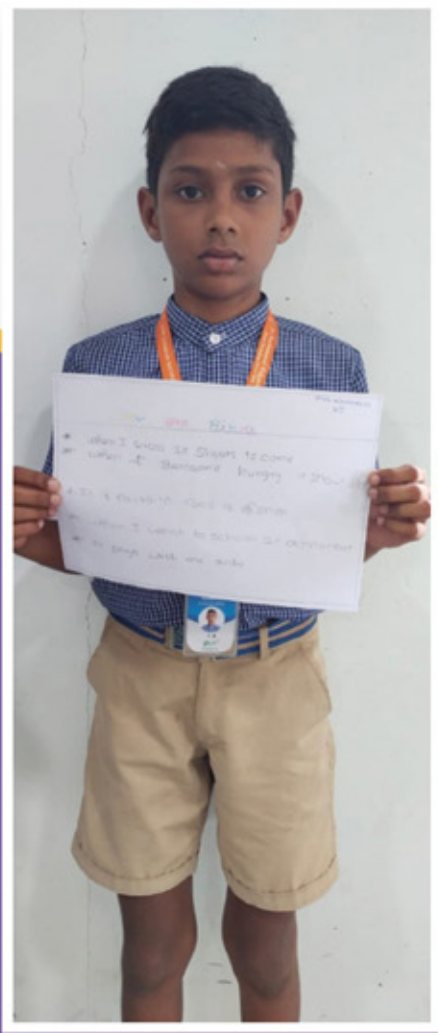
