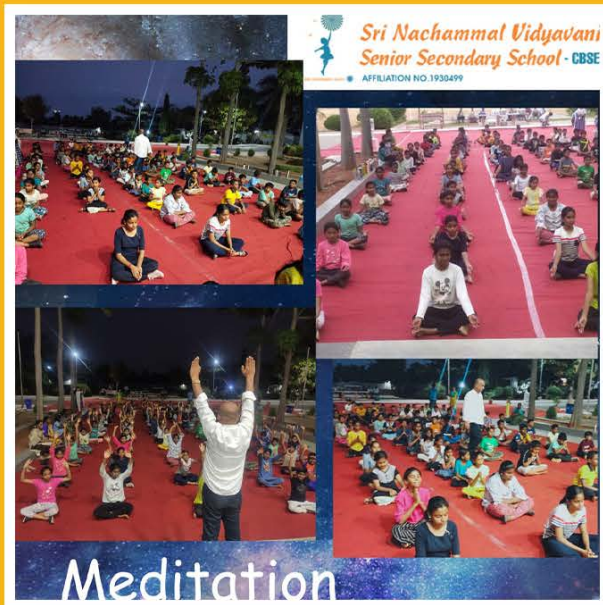

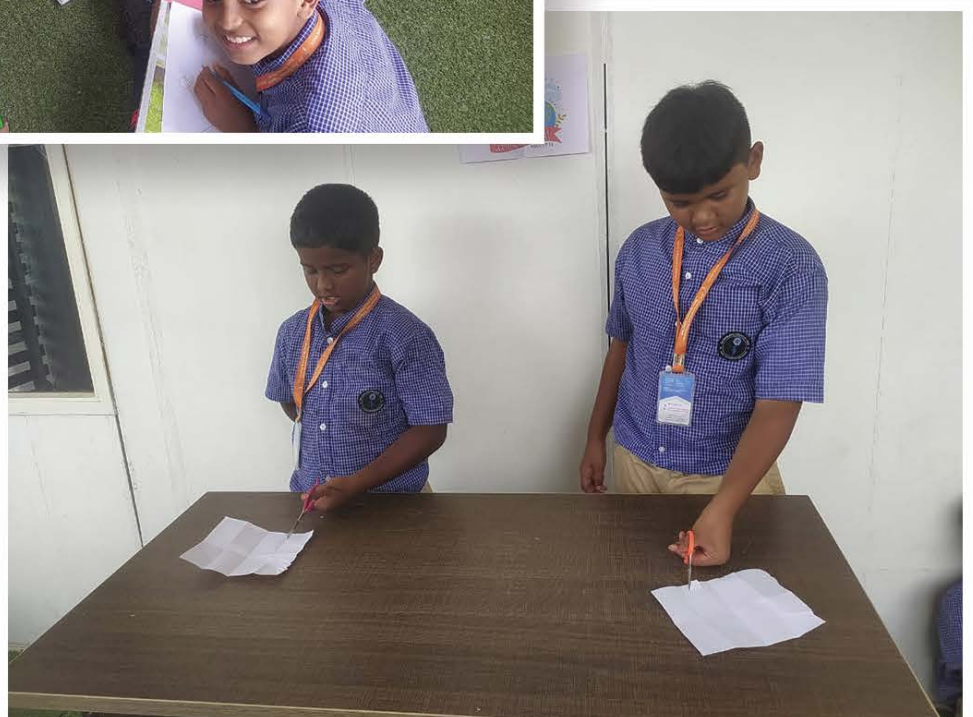
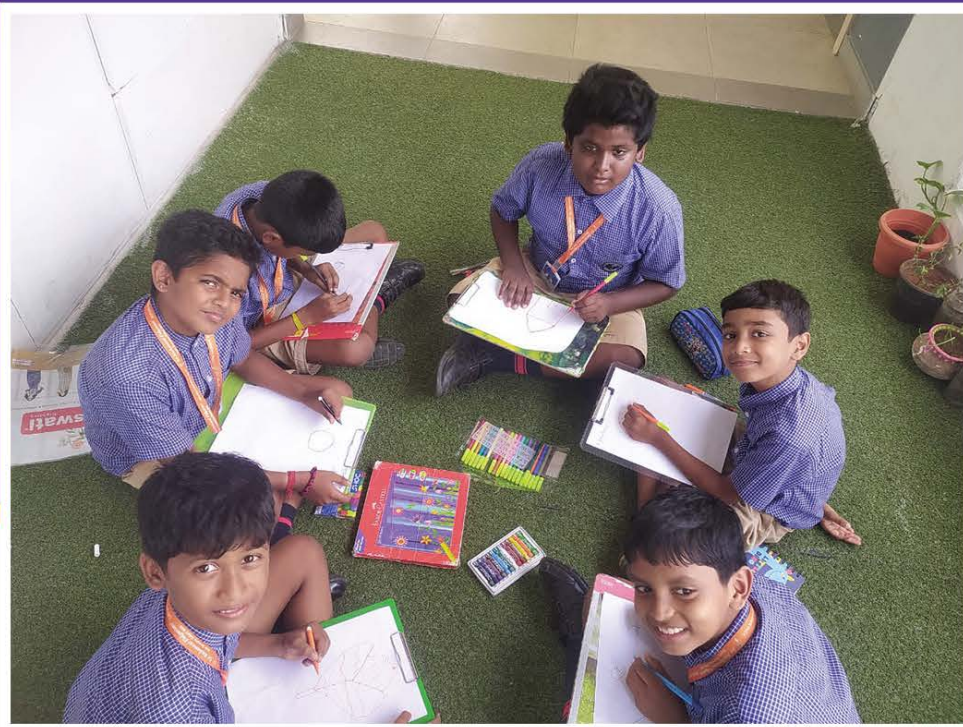
"Harini S, Grade XI C: A Stellar Speech on Chandrayaan 3's Success"
