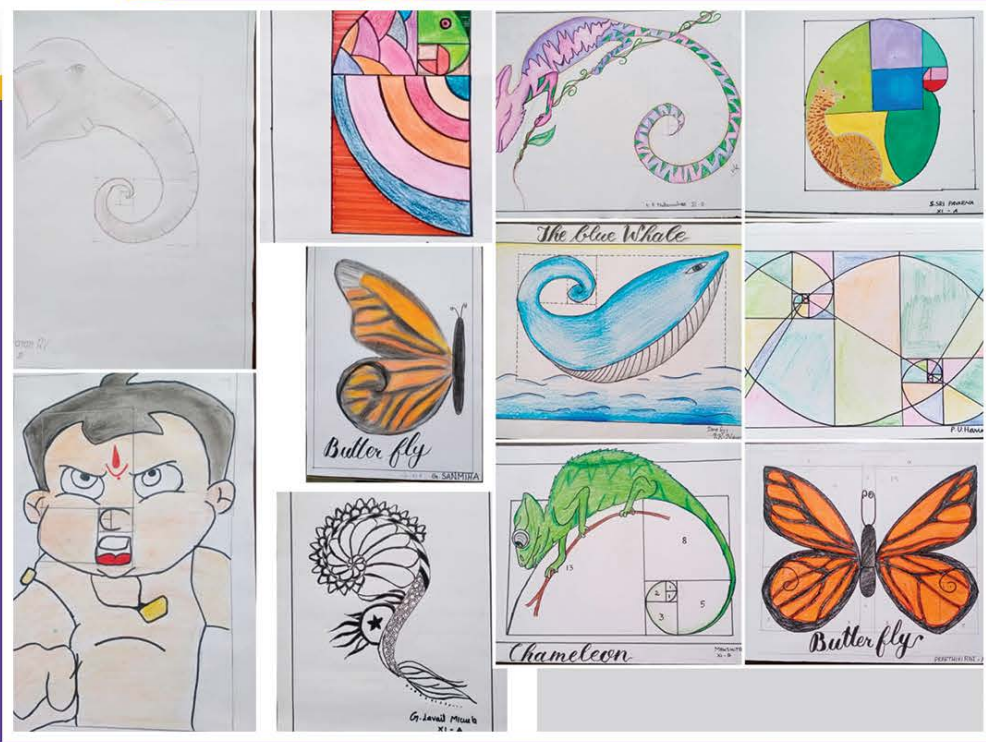
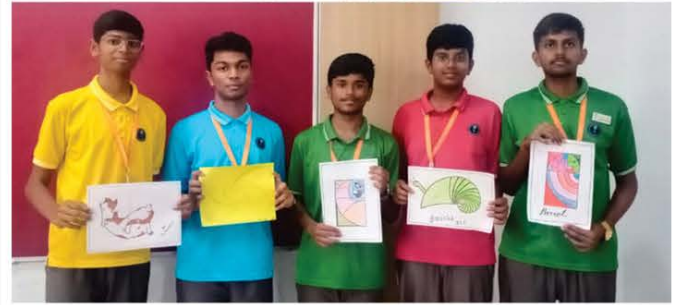


Spiraling Creativity: Fibonacci Day Extravaganza

Students Embrace Traditional Smudging Ceremony for Cleansing and Purification

Smudging is traditionally a ceremony for purifying or cleansing the soul of negative thoughts of a person or place.

During a smudge plant leaves or stems are placed in the container and ignited. The flames are then gently blown out and the smoke, which heals the mind, heart and body, is wafted over the person, either by hand or with an eagle feather.

Smudging activity was done by our grade VII students by burning plants and leaves like Neem, Tulsi, Moringa flower, Malabar nut, Vetiver and Indian Borage. Children smudged by holding the container and directing the smoke over themselves and others.

Navigating Futures: SNVV's Empowering Career Guidance Program

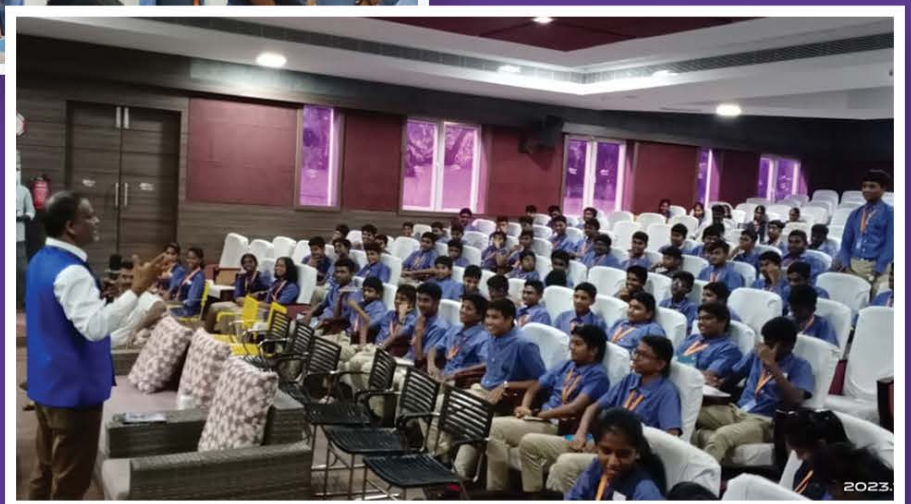
