## Critical thinking activity

Researchers have found that understanding and being able to identify recurring patterns allow us to develop essential skills of critical thinking and logic. So when you see your child building a repeated pattern with blocks, recording a decreasing number pattern in their math journal, or creating a table of increasing multiples to solve a mathematical problem, you will know that they are building essential foundations for future learning.
