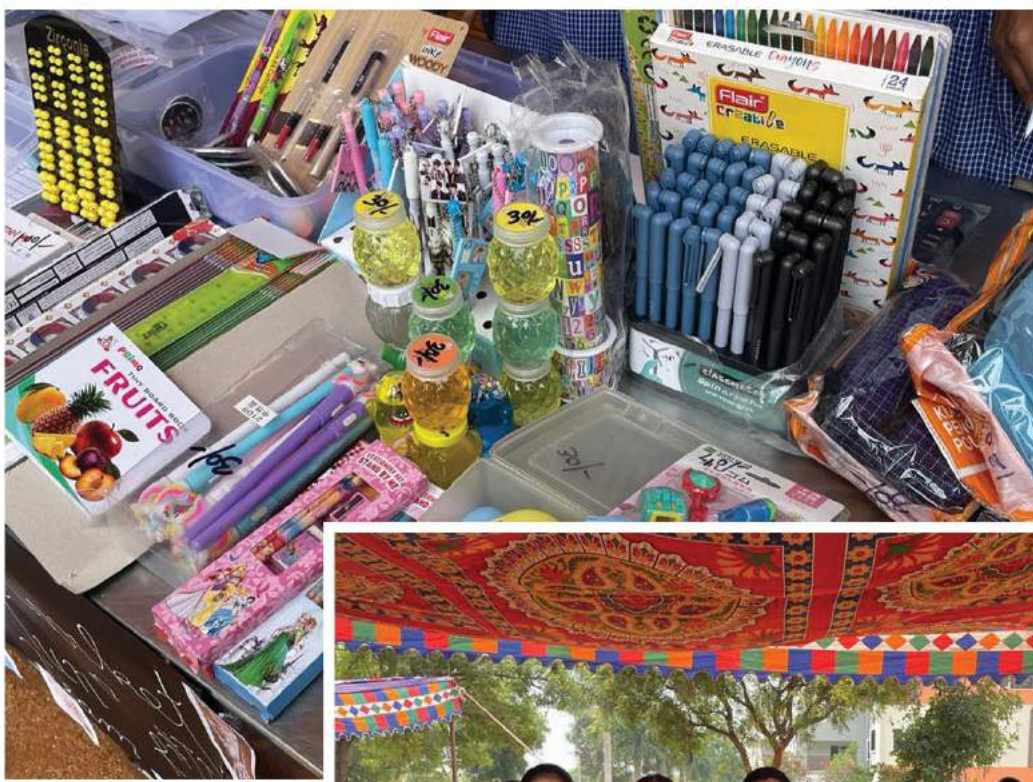
Because of this celebration, our Grade 6 students shared and enacted a scary story with their friends and enjoyed the time.
