Math Lab Activity

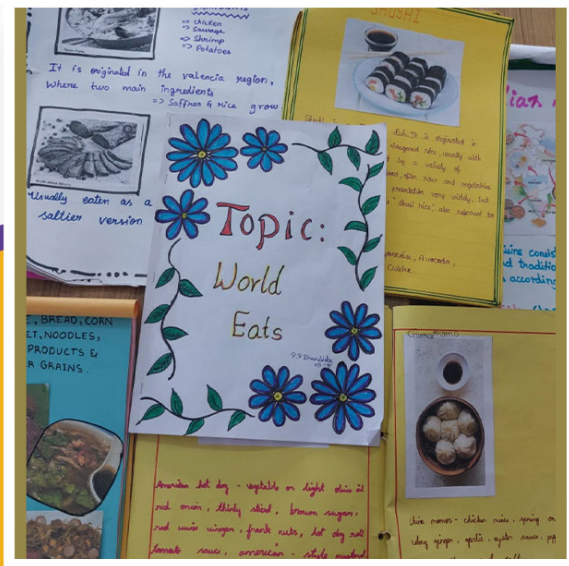
