## LEARNING ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

## Safety Champions: Grade 3 Emergency Response Challenge

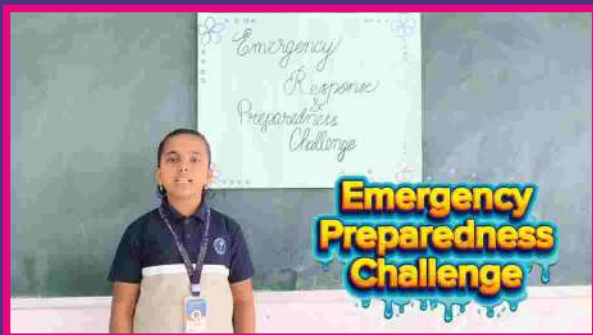

This celebration helped students understand and appreciate our rich cultural heritage and spiritual values.

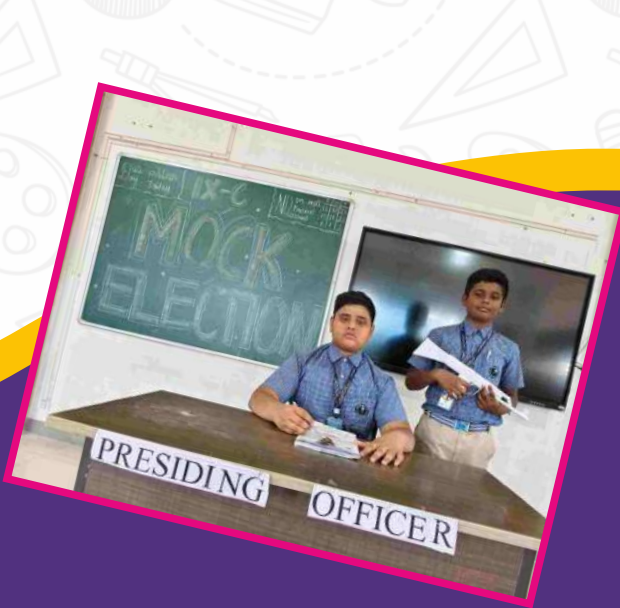


## “Election Booth Build” – Understanding Democracy in the Current Scenario

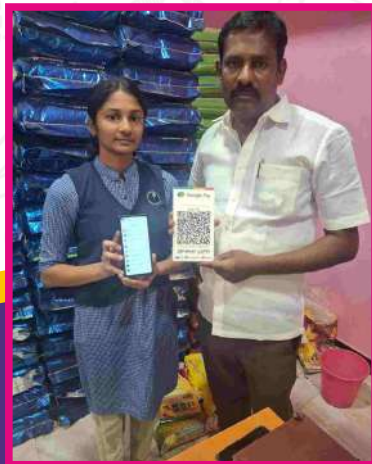
Activity: Digital Literacy Bridge Activity

Through trial and error, students tested the balance of the structure and observed how small changes affected its stability.

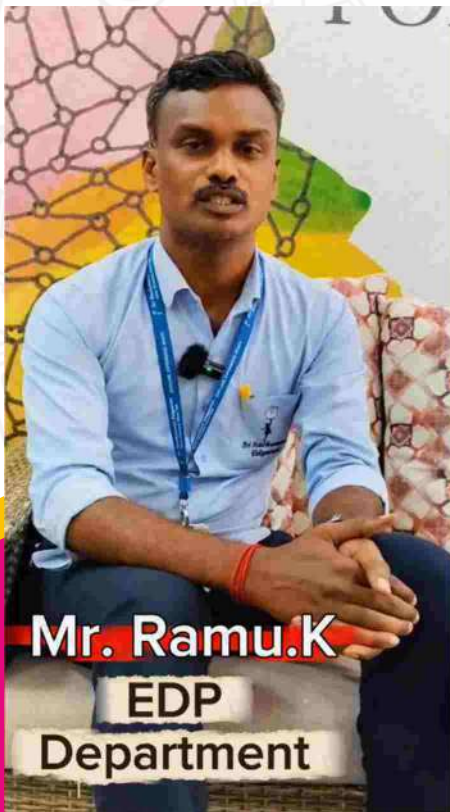
This activity helped them understand key Physics concepts such as load distribution, compression forces, and the role of gravity.

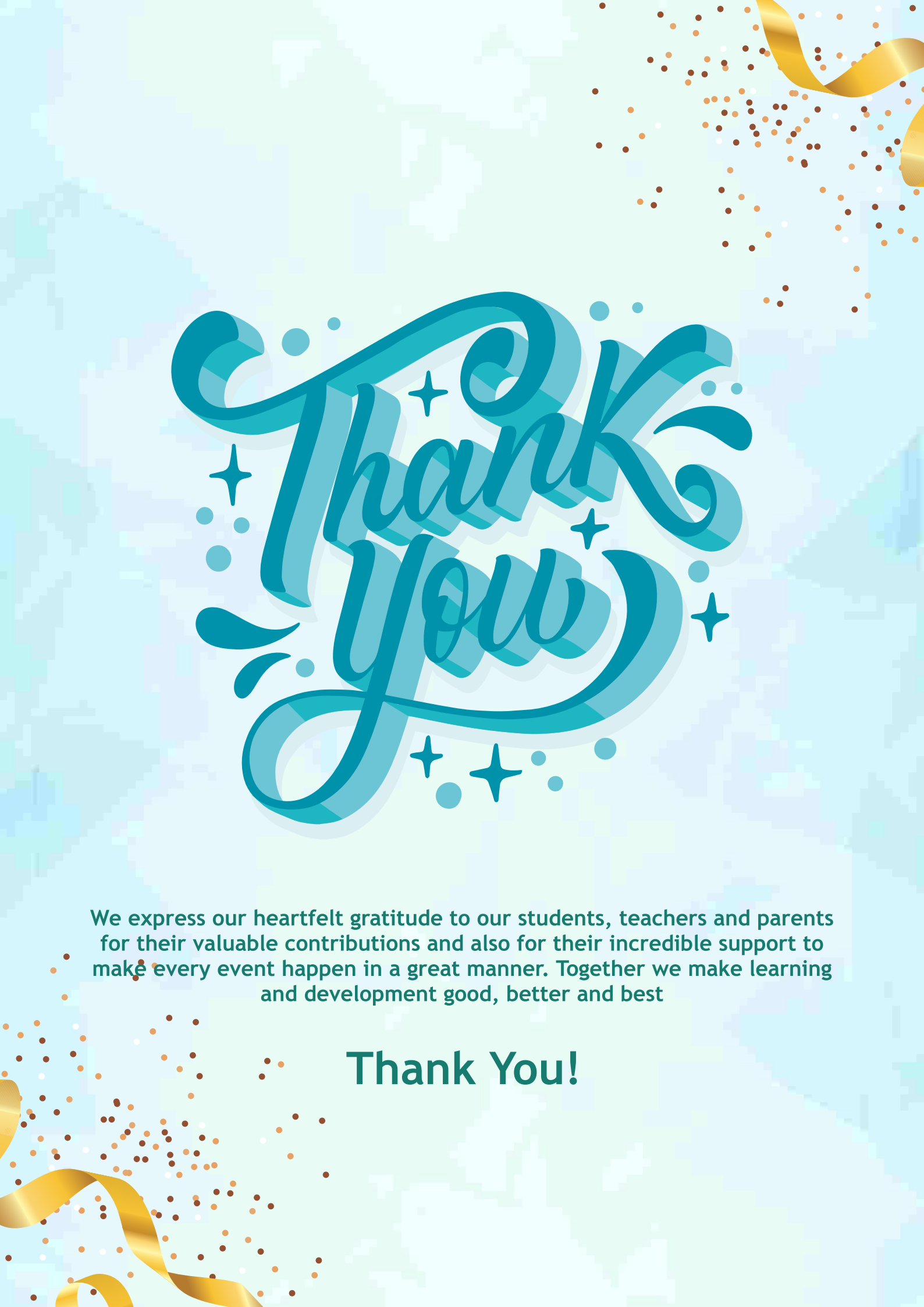
