

RECONSTITUTION OF LANDS BACK TO NATIVE TRIBES

POWERED BY CARBON CREDITS & PARTICIPATING ECO-GREEN BANKS



THERE WAS A SPECIAL, INDIGENOUS, SACRED, AND TREATIED LAND ON ZUG ISLAND THAT WAS STOLEN FROM NATIVE AMERICANS BY OIL-BASED AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRIALIZATION AND THE GOVERNMENT IN 1917.

Native American burial grounds were leveled, the Underground Railroad slave route was forgotten, and indigenous people were thoughtlessly eliminated. Factories went up, and heavy metals and chemicals were brought in. For 87 years, industry violated the land, water, and those that came before it - and then simply left. It left behind vast physical and emotional destruction, desecrated land and water, devoid of life – dark ecocide, unsafe and poisoned. It left behind land stripped of the indigenous honor and sanctity that once was coveted by the false protection of treaty. It left behind land that for decades supported those who escaped slavery.

Zug Island is now a site of unimaginable ecological and emotional historical trauma.

BUT CHANGE IS EMERGING, AND WE ARE IMAGINING SOMETHING NEW.

IMAGINE REVITALIZATION & A NEW "NET-ZERO URBAN VILLAGE"

In 2018, the City of Detroit embarked on the development of the new Gordie Howe International Bridge in Delray, adjacent to Zug Island and River Rouge. The bridge will span across the Detroit River to Canada, and is planned for completion in September 2025.

A group of individuals who have a history and very heavy heart for the people of Detroit, asked us to evaluate properties near the new bridge in Delray at Zug Island for best use. What we found was a multitude of opportunities to bring prosperity, hope – and healing.


Gordie Howe Bridge – honoring the past and present, and promoting future healing. The project plans to provide many dynamic opportunities:

THE IROQUOIS 7TH GENERATION OF CONSCIOUSNESS

The new "Net Zero Urban Village" use is rooted in the vision of the Iroquois' 7th Generation of Consciousness – a moral method of living and development. The 7th Generation principle is a concept that urges the current generation to live and work for the benefit of seven generations into the future. It is believed to have originated with the Great Law of the Iroquois, which is to "think seven generations ahead"



and decide whether the decisions that are made today would benefit our descendants." It is frequently associated with the modern, popular concept of environmental stewardship or sustainability, but is much broader in context. The Seventh Generation is a philosophy of the Iroquois Ancients written into their Sovereign Constitution.

OREN LYONS, CHIEF OF THE ONONDAGA NATION

WRITES: "We are looking ahead, as is one of the first mandates given to us as chiefs – to make sure and to make every decision that we make relate to the welfare and wellbeing of the seventh generation to come. What about the seventh generation? Where are you taking them? What will they have?"

IMAGINE 7TH GENERATION INITIATIVE MISSION STATEMENT & GREEN ECONOMY GOALS

- Achieve a net zero community in a highly advanced industrial society
- Create an affordable, new Urban Green Village nestled along the Detroit River, fully elevated 30' above the ground. The land beneath the Village will be open with vertical light shafts to promote living vertical forests. Rooftops will support gardens and greenhouses.
- Commit and employ an American Institute of Architects (AIA), Platinum LEED program for Village design, engineering and construction with a zero-carbon footprint
- Reconstitute lands back to Native Tribes
- Enable AI to create a Carbon Underwriting Lab for certification of products and services
- Shift from carbon-based economy to a sustainable green economy and green digital currency; high return tax carbon credits; Supported by participating non-profit eco-green banks and Native American Tribes; Endorsed by the US Government


WHAT IS HISTORICAL TRAUMA?

Historical Trauma is the accumulative emotional and psychological pain over an individual's lifespan and across generations, as the result of massive group trauma – such as racial discrimination, slavery genocide and ecocide. Historical trauma can have varied effects on individuals and populations, including depression, high mortality, alcohol abuse, child abuse and domestic violence. Historical trauma examples have been extensively researched among Lakota and other Native American populations, Holocaust survivors and descendants. The sites at Fort Wayne, Delray and Zug Island hold hundreds of years of historical trauma locked inside them – the extent of which is now being uncovered, in order for the healing and revitalization process to begin.



EARLY INNOVATION & PARTNERSHIPS

7G & Detroit Partnership

7G is budgeting \$11.5B for the New Urban Net-Zero Village and revitalization of Zug Island, Delray, Fort Wayne and River Rouge sites. Significant portions of project expenditures will go to local and Detroit-based businesses which will result in tax and job creation benefits. Additionally, the shift from the carbon-based economy to the new Green Economy will yield \$3 trillion in carbon credit financial exchanges. 7G will hire significant staff within the City for business infrastructure, and engage local electricians, plumbers, drywallers, general contractors and other construction personnel. 7G is fully committed to being an active partner to the local community and City of Detroit during the construction and operation of the development. Future job opportunities at the Village will be in the hundreds of millions.
