

FINANCIAL NEED CRITERIA

MODERATE

- Dual-income or stable single-income household
- One or two dependents
- Parents/guardians employed full-time or consistently part-time
- Ability to cover most costs with partial assistance

Family can manage basic costs but needs help easing the burden of sports or education expenses

CLEAR

- Single-income household or mixed full-time/part-time employment
- Two or more dependents
- Competing expenses (multiple children in sports, education costs, travel)
- Partial ability to self-fund but assistance is required to continue participation

Without sponsorship, continued participation would be difficult or inconsistent

SIGNIFICANT

- Single-parent or low-income household
- Part-time, seasonal, or unstable employment
- Three or more dependents
- Applicant cannot continue without meaningful assistance

Funding is required to prevent withdrawal from sport, education, or development pathway

HIGH

- No household income or reliance on social assistance
- Unemployment or temporary work
- High cost-of-living pressures with limited support systems
- Multiple dependents
- No ability to self-fund

Funding is critical to remain on academic or elite/professional pathway



Financial need levels are guidelines only and do not automatically determine tier eligibility. All applications are reviewed holistically, and funding amounts are based on demonstrated need, pathway alignment, and the specific amount required.
