This property lies within both our Primary and Secondary Well Head Protection Areas, giving us greater oversight of the land that directly impacts our water system. Following cleanup and environmental assessment, we hope to collaborate with the Clinton Parks & Recreation Department to develop walking trails throughout the property. This scenic space has the potential to become a haven for birdwatchers, nature enthusiasts, and families looking to enjoy the outdoors. From peaceful hikes to educational opportunities, the site will offer a unique blend of conservation and recreation. Stay tuned for updates as we work to transform this land into a vibrant community resource.

Reminder: Backflow Device Installation Helps Protect Our Water System

As part of our recent meter upgrade project, many customers were notified of the need to install a backflow prevention device. We'd like to thank those who have already completed their installation and reached out to confirm—your prompt action helps keep our water system safe.

If you were informed that a backflow device is required and haven't yet contacted us, please let the Clinton Water District know whether the installation has been completed. If it hasn't, we ask that you reach out to discuss your timeline or inquire about any assistance we may be able to provide.

Backflow prevention devices are essential for protecting the town's water supply from potential contaminants. Your cooperation ensures the continued safety and reliability of our community's drinking water.
