She is a research associate at the University of Montreal Hospital Research Center, as well as Data Access advisor at the Quebec Research Fund for Healthcare and Associate Professor at the University of Montreal School of Public Health.

Cécile Petitgand holds a doctorate in Management from the University of Paris-Dauphine and the University of Sao Paulo (Brazil), and a master's degree in Economics from the Paris School of Economics. She did her post-doctorate at the Health Hub: Politics, Organizations and Law of the University of Montreal focusing on the issue of AI implementation in Canadian hospitals.

Cécile Petitgand is also a researcher for the International Observatory on the Societal Impacts of AI and Digital Technology (OBVIA) and the Justicia legal research group of the University of Montreal. Her expertise relates in particular to the responsible development and implementation of AI systems in healthcare organizations.
