After honor is called to the name of the deceased, the words spoken by the leader of the ceremony are short, yet poignant and true to the spirit of Sigma Chi

In as much as our dearly beloved brother wore over his heart The White Cross of Sigma Chi whose immaculate whiteness symbolized to us the purity of his motive therefore, it is most appropriate that he now bear above his heart our emblem; and that we lay white roses upon his casket in token of the sweet memories we will always cherish of him we loved so well."

significant Sig JOHN ZIEGLER JR., MICHIGA $955^{*}$, entered the Chapter Eternal on Oct. 25 , 2018. He was 84. Ziegler was born on Feb. 9, 1934 Grosse Pointe, Michigan. He earned his bachelor' nd law degrees from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor before working for Olympia Stadium in of the Detroit Red Wings of the NHL. From 1977 to 992, Ziegler was the NHL's fourth president and oversaw the growth of the league from 18 to 24 eams. He received the Significant Sig Award in 1986 and was elected to the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1987. JOHN AYRES, HOUSTON 1968 *, entered the Chapter Eternal on Oct. 4, 2018. He was 74. Ayres was born on Jan. 25, 1944, in Dallas. He earned his bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Houston and worked in the power CB\&I Co. in Beaumont, Texas.
