In 2008, what started as an effort to save the Thomas Lyon House, one of the oldest unaltered homes in Connecticut, from demolition, has evolved into a broader preservation mission, to educate the community regarding history and preservation, as well as, preserving other historical structures. To accomplish this mission, Jo founded the Greenwich Preservation Trust. In addition to the Thomas Lyon House, among many of its accomplishments GPT has protected; the Little Bethel AME Church, the Thomas Lyon Cemetery on Byram Shore Rd. and designated The Thomas Lyon House on the Connecticut Freedom Trail.

Through the years she has tirelessly worked on the projects and never faltered as being a dedicated, committed, loving and loyal wife to her late husband Dr. Kevin E. Conboy, mother to Margaret and Jeremiah and grandmother to Hunter, as well as a friend to so many.
