



Amalfi Town Hall, Amalfi Coast

Situated next to the beautiful Duomo of St Andrew, the 14th century Amalfi Town Hall, where your civil ceremony will be conducted, is a former Benedictine Monastery dating back to the 12th century. It is believed to be one of the oldest marriage halls in Italy.

The hall is called the Salone Morelli and is also a maritime civic museum containing many important documents and historic furnishings. The hall holds up to 70 guests and weddings are conducted in Italian, with a translator provided. This beautiful building overlooks the sea, perfect for spectacular photo opportunities after your ceremony. We highly recommend heading to the magnificent Arabian Cloister of Paradise after your wedding for more photographs. Then, against the rugged cliffs of Amalfi you could head to the iconic 13th Century cliff-edged Grand Hotel Convento di Amalfi for a splendid reception with spellbinding sea views.

Italy makes a great wedding destination as it's a lot closer to home, making it more accessible for family and friends to celebrate with you on your wedding day.
