Robert Allen "Bob" Robison, 87, of Jefferson City, passed away Thursday, October 25, 2018. Bob enthusiastically worked on old cars. He proudly owned a 1931 Model A Ford coupe and a 1955 Chevy Bel-Air sport coupe. In addition to being a member of the Mid-MO Old Car Club, he was also a member of the Mid Missouri Model A Ford Club, the National Model A Restorer's Club and served as a judge in fine point automotive contests. Bob recently participated in the Honor Flight program, travelling to Washington D.C. to visit the memorials dedicated to honor the service and sacrifices of our veterans. Bob served in the United States Navy from 1950-1954 covering the period of the Korean Conflict. Bob's survivors include his wife Bonnie--they were blessed with sixty-two years of marriage together; four sons, Robert (Elizabeth) Robison, Jr., Chesterfield, Missouri; James (Kimberly) Robison, Germantown, Tennessee; Donald (Jana) Robison, Wildwood, Missouri; Ronald (Amy) Robison, LaGrange, Kentucky; and eleven grandchildren.

Linda Slanker, age 70, of California, Mo., died on Halloween, October 31, 2018. Linda started and initially funded the Mid-Mo Old Car Club Scholarship Fund, which has done very well the past eight years. Linda and Todd Slanker were married in London, England in 1994.
