convertibles and two door classic cars were



May 28. We will also **postpone** our planned April 25 trip to Kelsey Tire in Camdenton.


In the meantime, the Saturday morning coffee guys are now getting together via ZOOM at 8am on Saturdays, the emails are more frequent with varied topics, and the






