The Brewster Ford. A 1934 Brewster Towne car and a 1935 roadster. Brewster was a luxury coach builder founded in Connecticut in 1810 as a high end luxury carriage builder. They later produced luxury automobiles including Rolls Royce. In the 30's depression, they tried making affordable luxury coaches using Ford chassis. With a price of approximately \$3,500, the Brewsters were more affordable than any Rolls-Royce but still too expensive for most people and the company ended at public auction in 1937.






A "Knock Down Kit" B-24H. When Ford began building B-24s at Willow Run it was only doing subassemblies and parts. This led to complete airplanes in kit form which were shipped to Tulsa Oklahoma by rail for assembly. The production of these kits continued even after Willow Run started building finished airplanes.





This 1926 Wolseley-Vickers car was equipped with both tracks and regular wheels so the vehicle could be driven around like a traditional car or it could lower its tracks to tackle rougher terrain like a tank.



Penetrating Oils Compared






