February 27, 1851 - The Missouri Legislature authorized the state's first highway improvements, the construction of plank roads by private corporations. The plank roads were financial failures. Among them was the St. Charles Road, which was "rocked" in 1865 when the plank road failed. Another plank road was an extension of Olive Street to Howell's Ferry on the Missouri River and one was also built to Hall's Ferry on the Missouri. In the photo, the old plank road is visible beneath the muck. (Unknown location)

Todd Slanker reminded the Club that he and his wife started and initially funded the scholarship fund and he would contribute the amount of funds needed to make the \$4,000 needed. Todd was thanked.

Upcoming events were mentioned including the California Ham and Turkey Festival on September 17 and a potential club trip to the “Back to the Farm Reunion in Boonville” on September 11.

Wes and Betty were thanked for hosting and providing the meal.

Meeting adjourned at 6:45pm and the Trunk Swap continued.
