Mr. Vernon Raymond Towner, age 96, of Jefferson City, Mo., passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 1, 2021 at Primrose Retirement Community.

Vernon was born October 11, 1924, in Ness City, Ks., the son of Raymond Weand Etta M. (Zuehlke) Towner.

Vernon was a 1942 graduate of Smith Cotton High School in Sedalia, Mo. and a 1945 graduate with an associate in science degree from Hannibal LaGrange College in Hannibal, Mo.

It was during college that he met Laura Louise Parsons while they were singing in a mixed quartet. They were married on July 28, 1946 in Bowling Green, Mo.

After college, Vernon taught radio repair in Kansas City to Armed Forces servicemen. He moved to Jefferson City and founded Towner Radio in 1947, which later became Towner Communications Systems. The business quickly expanded from selling and repairing radios into televisions and eventually into telecommunications. He was proud to transfer the business in 1994 to the second generation of his family and he continued helping part time even to work alongside the third generation.

Vernon was an active member of First Baptist Church in Jefferson City. He served in numerous capacities including deacon and was a pre-school Sunday school teacher for over 60 years. He was passionate about music and shared that talent with his wife. They sang in the choir together and performed several duets in worship at church. He was a member of the lefferson City Host Lions Club and assisted faithfully every year with their fundraising events. He was an avid fan of the Jefferson City Jays, Mizzou, and the St. Louis Cardinals.






