2024 District 10 Interlock Fall Rules

1. A pitcher can only pitch in 2 innings per game.

Six consecutive outs or 5 runs are meet.

A pitcher cannot return if pulled early.

No 12-year-old to pitch in minor A (AAA) baseball and softball.

(Juniors may pitch one player 3 innings).

Pitch count resorts to the Little League Rule book.

- 2. Bench bat rule applies to all games.
- 3. Maximum 5 runs can score per 1/2 inning. No unlimited six/seventh inning.
- 4. No mercy rule in effect.
- 5. No new inning will start: (No drop dead).
 - a. AAA/Majors After 2 hours
 - b. Juniors/Seniors After 2 hours 30 minutes
- 6. Each player must play in a minimum of 3 innings per game.
- 7. One defensive coach can be on the field for each of players in the minor division. Two other defensive coaches remain in the dugout.
- 8. The home team will supply 2 new balls for each game.
- 9. The home team is responsible for 2 umpires. Must be at least one adult umpire on the field.
- 10. The home team is responsible for preparing the field prior to the game.
- 11. Both teams are responsible for the cleanup of each dugout and the stands.
- 12. Players that are league age 13 years (per the 2024 age determination charts) must play in the Juniors divisions to pitch (baseball and softball).
- 13.**Softball (AAA) only** Coach can pitch to batter on bases loaded. Coach must be in the circle.
- 14. All other rules for the game follow the 2024 Little League Rule Book.
