# WHAT TO EXPECT



### FIELD DECORUM

We want this to be a great experience for everyone so that lasting memories are made for your young ladies. Please ensure your Manager's review, and share, the below details about our park.

The following rules at Federal Way National Little League Park:

- 1. No use of tobacco/vape products while on-premises, in the field, or parking lot.
- 2. No use of alcohol products while on-premises, at the field.
- 3. No consumption of marijuana while on-premises, at the field, or the parking lot.
- 4. No dogs on the field
- 5. no skateboards, hoverboards, etc. in or around field area or stands.
- 6. please not block the view of fans in the stands with "easy ups", tarps, or otherwise. these shade mechanisms can be used around the field so long as they do not block the view of fans.
- 7. please put trash in the proper receptacles.
- 8. there will be a concession stand available with concessions, there may also be food trucks and other vendors for food and beverages. All concessions will accept cash, some will accept credit and debit cards.
- 9.On field photography/videography is not permitted except by/for specific pre-arranged vendors and news media. If taking pictures or videos, please be considerate and do not block the view of the fans.
- 10.No parents or spectators are allowed to communicate with players, managers, or coaches after the teams are on the field and take occupancy of the dugouts.
- 11. Park in parking areas only. Do not park on grass or block traffic.
- 12. There are no animals allowed at the complex.





# WHAT TO EXPECT



### LINEUP SHEETS

The lineups will be provided to the umpires at the plate meeting.

One hour prior to your assigned game time you will provide copies to the tournament director (or his/her designee). This pre-game meeting will also include the coin-flip. If a manager is missing at this meeting, that manager forfeits their call to the manager available.



### PLAYER INTRODUCTIONS

All players will be introduced at their first game in the tournament.



### PARTICIPATION PINS

All players will be re-introduced and provided participation pins at their final game.





# WHAT TO EXPECT



### HOUSING

District 10 is not providing housing or lodging for this tournament to those districts requiring it. The districts requiring housing should use the suggested lodging provided as part of this packet.



### FIELD PERSONNEL

Managers, coaches, and players on the affidavit are the only participants allowed inside the playing fence before, during, or after the game. There are no exceptions.



### **TOURNAMENT UMPIRES**

The tournament umpires are all volunteers. We will not tolerate any harrassment or condemnation of them. The discussions with the umpires should be in a calm and professional manner. Managers, coaches, or players may be removed from the game per Little League rules if behavior is deemed inappropriate.

If you have any comments about umpires in the tournament, please discuss this privately with our District 10 Umpire-in-Chief (UIC).


