

Also private lessons are a wonderful option to customize your training to fit YOUR schedule and YOUR family's needs with <u>no distractions.</u> All training begins with an assessment and baseline to build a training plan or make a referral if needed.

\$89- Assessment fee (includes temperament test if needed, a training and behavior modification plan you may start on right away.) Assessment fees are waived if you buy a package. (a lesson is taken from your package to pay for the training portion.) If it is appropriate to conduct an in-home assessment/training session, we offer those starting at \$145 for the initial meeting. Travel surcharges may apply if over 10-mile radius. (call for pricing) * Service Dog Assessments in office are \$125 due to the additional testing and forms needed

Steps to booking a private lesson or Assessment:

1.) We book appointments on <u>Tuesday's through some Saturday's</u>

between 9am-3pm
Saturdays - 9am-1

2.) All training (except group classes) starts with a private assessment. It's easy to book an appointment, just email us at <u>k9capers@gmail.com</u> or call at 704 721-6757 <u>All appointments should be</u> confirmed by email or phone call before you bring your dog.

3.) **Scheduling and payments are easy!** We take checks, cash and all major credit cards including discover and American Express.

4.) What to bring:

A regular leash, your dogs favorite toys, (1 cup of dry and a can of wet food if you do the full temperament testing). Please bring soft treats such as hot dog slices or bil-jac treats for the training portion. String cheese works well also. Current veterinarian records . <u>Vaccines required are a current rabies and what age appropriate vaccines required by your veterinarian.</u> Videos of your issues will help also.

5.) <u>What to expect:</u> when you arrive for your appointment, please come to the door to let us know you have arrived. You will be given further instructions. If we do not answer the door, call us! 704 721 6757 or 704 791 9888. You will be treated with kindness and respect. We want to help you!

6.) Please keep your dog with you at all times and pick up after your dog. We have doggie poop bags if you need them. It is best not to introduce your dog to other people or dogs until we have done an assessment. We want to see the first reactions in our office.

Training Treats and Toys:

Please bring Treats, Toys and Praise! You should especially bring high value treats such as meat and cheese as well as lower value such as dry kibble. Bring your dog's favorite toy and plan on a great time!

Vaccinations Required:

All dogs over 16 weeks should have a current rabies vaccination. We <u>do</u> accept titers for older dogs similar the Therapy Dog International protocol.

All puppies must have at least 1 set of vaccines 1 week before classes begin. You must have <u>proof of vaccines</u> from a veterinarian or an acceptable rescue group. We support your veterinarian recommendations for your pet.

Equipment needed: Flat buckle or snap collar, or a front clip harness, and 6 foot leather or nylon leash.

No choke chains, prong collars, shock or electronic collars. Equipment of this kind is not needed for the classes.

Cancellation and Missed lessons: We will miss you if you are unable to attend a lesson after registration. We are <u>unable to offer refunds</u> or discounts for missed lessons. If you would like to schedule a make up session for a particular missed lesson, please let us know. A 24–48 hour notice is required to receive a reschedule or your lesson is forfeited. Funds must be used in 60 days of purchase or from scheduled date. Unused portions are donated to our non-profit, Katie's Kids Pals (service and comfort dog training program). Group classes must be made up when offered.
