Here is her profile written by her handler and dad:

From rescue pup to hospital hero, Grace, the beagle, has touched hundreds of lives with her wagging tail and gentle spirit. In February 2025, she earned her official therapy dog certification through Therapy Dogs United in

partnership with K-9 Capers. Just a month later, she began her volunteer service at Atrium Cabarrus Hospital.



Since then, Grace has completed 31 hospital visits, bringing comfort to more than 700 patients, caregivers, and staff members. Nurses, patients, and hospital team members alike cherish her gentle presence, warm demeanor, and natural calmness.

Service Dogs in Training

After many months of training, our students will be tested using the Federal Government's standard required by the American Disabilities Act (ADA) Department called the Public Access Test. It is quite extensive, and takes time to achieve. We train in many public spaces such as restaurants, grocery stores, museums, malls, bus stations, and more.

We must also meet the states' requirement of training and register though the NC Health Department upon completion of the training. A trainer, must verify the handler and dog are in compliance with the training hours and required tasks.

Fake Service Dogs

Regulations in the service dog industry are in place, however, many people, and some trainers are NOT in compliance which poses problems and safety issues with seeing-eye dogs, mobility dogs, and other service dogs. Violations could mean jail time/or

fines. We are certified service dog trainers. Let us guide you to make certain you meet federal and state regulations.



Choosing a training method

Our methods of training are positive reinforcement meaning, we use food, toys, petting, praise, and places they want to go-like the park! We use this method as we want to train a dog not to react, but to use cognitive reasoning.

What classes do you offer?

We like to start all of our puppies in our Puppy Development Program we have designed for our service dog puppies. In this program, we go on field trips, have play groups, and work on specific issues,

It lays a great foundation for all puppies, including pet dogs.

We also offer all American Kennel Club classes, including the AKC STAR Puppy, the AKC Canine Good Citizen, and beyond.

Therapy Dog Prep Classes

We offer therapy dog group classes and testing 3-4 times a year.

Therapy dogs must pass the AKC Canine Good Citizen and the TDU test.

AKC Scent Work

We now offer the AKC Scent Work class. It is a competitive class based on police detective work.

We have group or private lessons. All dogs of any age can do this class!
